DID YOU KNOW...

- ✓ PortMiami's **economic impact** continues to grow – new figures, updated just last month, show that the Port contributes **\$27 billion** annually to the local and state economies – up 50% from five years ago. PortMiami supports **207,000 jobs**, both directly and indirectly. That's 25,000 more jobs than just five years ago.
- ✓ Commercial Real Estate giant Jones Lang LaSalle ranks PortMiami in their **top 10 best places for commercial real estate investment**, making Miami-Dade County's **150 million square feet** of warehouse space even more attractive to investors looking to set up their warehousing and distribution centers.
- ✓ PortMiami has purchased four new **Super Post-Panamax gantry cranes**, currently under construction in China and expected to arrive on-port this summer. Among the largest in the world, each crane has a lift height of 141 feet, an outreach of 223 feet, and can hold 65 long tons under its spreader.
- ✓ PortMiami's **Deep Dredge** project will employ the same **stringent environmental protocols** established by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers for dredging in the Florida Keys National Marine Sanctuary.
- ✓ **China** is PortMiami's **top trading partner** with 1.6 million tons annually. Our number two partner, Honduras, is at less than half that amount with 682,262 tons, and the Dominican Republic comes in third with 574,719 tons.
- ✓ The new PortMiami **Foreign Trade Zone (FTZ) 281** is based on the national model which **reduces paperwork, implementation and activation time** required to start FTZ operations. FTZs enable companies to **reduce, defer or eliminate tariffs** due on goods imported through the Miami Customs District.
- ✓ The **Panama Canal Expansion**, expected to cost an estimated \$5.25 billion, requires the removal of 8.7 million cubic meters of material from the Canal's Pacific side and the removal of nearly 17.9 million cubic meters of material from the Atlantic side – ten times the amount of concrete used to build the Hoover Dam!
- ✓ The new **PortMiami - FEC Connection** offers shippers the fastest access to Southeastern U.S. consumer markets, allowing goods to **reach 70% of the U.S. population in 1-4 days**.
- ✓ The **first cruise ship** sailed from the Port in 1966. Today, 14 cruise lines operate from PortMiami, known around the world as the *Cruise Capital of the World*.™
- ✓ Once completed, the **Port Tunnel** will **remove more than 1 million vehicles** from downtown streets annually. Scheduled for completion in 2014, the Port Tunnel will provide direct access between Port facilities and the Interstate System.



TOP TEN EXPORT COUNTRIES




