REQUIREMENTS FOR INSURANCE CERTIFICATE, CONSENT TO TARIFF and INDEMNIFICATION

PORT MIAMI TARIFF No. 010 - SECTION TWO - ITEM 224

All users of the Port facilities are required to carry Comprehensive General Liability insurance and/or Automobile Liability insurance and to furnish Port Miami with a Certificates of Liability Insurance. Such insurance shall be in amounts not less than \$100,000 per person and \$300,000 per accident for bodily injury, and \$50,000 per accident for property damage. Insurance policies for general and vehicle liability must show Miami Dade County as both CERTIFICATE HOLDER and ADDITIONAL INSURED.

PORT MIAMI TARIFF No. 010 - SECTION TWO - ITEM 202

The use of the waterways and piers, wharves, bulkheads, docks and other facilities under the jurisdiction of the Seaport Department shall constitute a consent to the terms and conditions of this tariff and evidence an agreement on the part of vessels, their owners and agents and other users of such waterways and facilities to pay all charges specified in this tariff and be governed by all rules and regulations published herein.

Permit applicant agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Miami-Dade County from any and all liability, losses or damages arising out of, resulting from or relating to the applicant's use of Port facilities. Permit applicant is responsible for all applicable fees, rules and regulations as contained in Port of Miami Tariff No. 010. Permit renewals not received by the expiration date are considered late and the initial processing fee is required for reinstatement. The undersigned represents that he/she has authority to submit this application on behalf of the above-named entity. The permit applicant agrees to comply with all applicable laws, including the Code of Miami-Dade County, Port of Miami Terminal Tariff No. 010 and all regulations or directives issued by the Port Director or Seaport Department staff.
