

Hazardous Materials Safety and Security - Awareness Level Training

March 27th, 2014 (8 hours of classroom instruction)

The **Awareness** level course involves eight hours of classroom instruction, case studies, and interactive tabletop scenarios emphasizing the concept of being aware of the materials that are handled, transported, or loaded and unloaded, through mechanisms such as labels and markings, Emergency Response Guidebook (ERG), or information stations. In addition, this course stresses to the participants the idea of observe and report, with an emphasis on keeping themselves and others a safe distance from the hazardous material.
