Miami-Dade County Public Works and Waste Management Department **PTP ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS** **SW 27th Avenue from Tigertail Avenue to SW 28th Terrace** **ROADWAY CONSTRUCTION**

Project Description:

The project is located on SW 27th Avenue from Tigertail Avenue to SW 28th Terrace, within Miami-Dade County Commission District # 7. Work includes, but is not limited to, reconstructing the existing two lane road with raised landscape medians, on street parking, bike lane, sidewalks, curb and gutter, storm drainage system, signalization, traffic calming circle, pavement markings and signage, decorative lighting and demolition of an encroaching building into the right-of-way.

The work of this project also includes, but is not limited to, furnishing and installing ductile iron water mains along SW 27th Avenue between Tiger Tail Avenue and Coconut Avenue, City of Miami, Florida. This work includes furnishing and installing all ductile iron pipe and fittings; furnishing and installing gate valves complete with riser pipe and valve box; furnishing and installing fire hydrant assemblies, single short and long service connections; making connections to existing water mains; furnishing and installing air release valves and flushing water valves; cleaning, testing and disinfecting the mains; and all other appurtenant and miscellaneous items and work for a complete and fully functional installation.

Construction Schedule:

Construction began in December 2013 and is anticipated to be completed in June 2015.*

**The Construction Schedule above is weather permitting.*

Temporary Roadway Closure Schedule:

The night work and roadway closure required for the water main connection at the southeast corner of Tigertail Avenue and SW 27th Avenue is scheduled to begin **Monday, May 19, 2014**. Construction will consist of the installing a 12" water main across both SW 27th Avenue and Tigertail Avenue and connecting to an existing water main. The duration of this closure is anticipated to be approximately five days; no work is permitted on Sunday. Temporary detour routes and signs will be installed during the night work hours. Your patience and understanding during these improvements is requested and appreciated.

Construction closure date from: 05-19-2014 to 05-23-2014.

Methodology and Efforts:

All efforts are being made to minimize the impact from the construction activities to area residents, schools, businesses and motorists. The area will be restored to its original condition immediately upon the completion.
