

## **Crandon Park Tennis Center**

### **Rules and Regulations**

- All players must check in with the Pro Shop attendant and must pay prior to receiving their court assignment, no later than 15 minutes after reservation start time.
- Players play at their own risk.
- All court fees must be paid at the Pro Shop prior to entering the courts.
- Only one (1) court can be reserved at one time.
- Courts are reserved on a first-come, first-served basis and can be made three (3) days in advance online at [miamidadeparks.com](http://miamidadeparks.com)
- Court reservations are for a specific time and not a specific court.
- Crandon Park Tennis Center has the right to move court reservations due to weather and court conditions, programming, tournaments, leagues, and groups in order to facilitate play and accommodate players and teams.
- Players must exit courts when there is lightning or rain. When lightning is present, players must remain off all courts for 30 minutes after the lightning has stopped.
- Players are responsible for disposing of their trash and used tennis balls, as well as lowering the umbrella prior to vacating the court.
- Rain checks can only be issued as system credit to a Park Link account; no credit card or cash refunds.
- All players must exit the court after their reserved time ends. If players want to extend their time, they must check back in at the Pro-Shop in person or by telephone.
- Abusive behavior/language will not be tolerated on or off the courts. Anyone in violation of this rule will be trespassed off the premises.
- Proper tennis attire, including regulation tennis shoes and shirts, is required at all times. No black soled or open toed shoes are allowed.
- Daily court fee rates: 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.; Primetime court fee rates: 5:00 p.m. to Close
- Pro Shop transactions and operations will end 45 minutes prior to Close; Court reservations and use will end 30 minutes prior to Close; Court lights will turn off 15 minutes prior to Close
- Only Pro Service lessons provided by Cliff Drysdale Management are allowed.
- No Baskets or more than six (6) tennis balls are allowed on court unless approved in advance by the tennis facility manager.
- No alcohol, dogs, pets, or drones are allowed in the park.
- Parking for all vehicles, including motorcycles, is in designated parking spaces only. Parking is for facility patrons only. Unauthorized vehicles, or vehicles not parked in a designated parking space, will be towed at the owner's expense.
- The stadium is closed and off-limits. Violators will be trespassed and subject to applicable laws and statutes.
