Dear Ryan White Part A and/or MAI Service Provider:

Enclosed are the 2008 Federal Poverty Guidelines (Annual Income Ranges) issued by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services that Miami-Dade County will adopt for FY 2008-09, beginning on March 1, 2008. These guidelines are used to determine client financial eligibility for certain federal programs, including the Ryan White Part A and the Minority AIDS Initiative (MAI) Programs. Financial eligibility is based on the client's gross household income.

Effective March 1, 2008 through February 28, 2009, these guidelines replace the "2007 HHS FEDERAL POVERTY GUIDELINES" document found in Section VI, page 3, of the "Ryan White Part A Service Delivery Guidelines Fiscal Year 2008-09 (YR 18), Revised January 15, 2008" book (gold cover). Please note, there are no longer any gaps between the income ranges. The Ryan White Service Delivery Information System (SDIS) will be programmed according to these new ranges. These Guidelines will also be posted on the Miami-Dade County Ryan White website: www.miamidade.gov/RyanWhite.

It is essential that all persons involved in direct provision of services under your organization's Part A and/or MAI service agreements be given a copy of this document immediately. Adherence to these guidelines is required in order to ensure that Part A and/or MAI-funded services are provided to individuals who meet the financial eligibility requirements outlined in the Fiscal Year 2008-09 Ryan White Part A Service Delivery Guidelines.

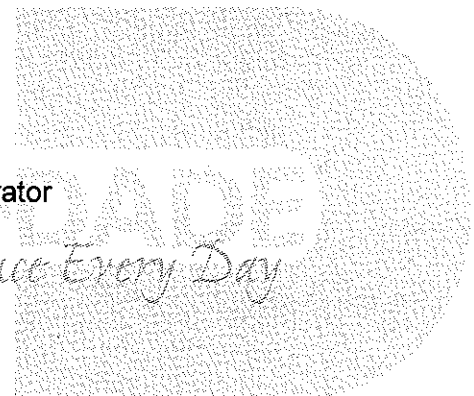
