#### Reasons for Recommendation

An analysis of the factors contained in Section V C of Implementing Order 3-32, as well as the responses of certified Small Business Enterprise -Architectural & Engineering (SBE-A&E) firms to the Verification of Availability to Propose process indicates that a 12.78% SBE-A&E Subconsultant Goal is appropriate for this contract. Attempts were made to make this contract a Set-Aside, however none of the firms responded to the Verification of Availability process as being able to satisfy the contract's requirements.
