#### Reasons for Recommendation

This project is a resubmittal and was advertised on 11/19/2015, with the Step 1 Proposals received on 12/21/2015. Subsequently, the overall cost of the project increased from \$2,267,790.74 to \$3,345,018.22 and the contract duration decreased from 620 to 528 calendar days.

This project meets all the criteria set forth in I.O. # 3-32, Section V.

Prime and Sub-consultants selected for PSAs under the following projects: E11-SEA-03, E14-SEA-01R, & EDP-SP-2015-025 will NOT be considered for award under this Agreement.

Initial attempts were made to make this a SBE/A&E Set-Aside, however, none of the firms were able to meet all of the project's requirements.

#### Reasons for Recommendation

This project is a resubmittal and was advertised on 11/19/2015, with the Step 1 Proposals received on 12/21/2015. Subsequently, the overall cost of the project increased from \$22,677,907.45 to \$33,450,182.24 and the contract duration decreased from 620 to 528 calendar days. Following SBD's review the SBE/Cons goal was increased from 8.92% to 9.87%.

An analysis of the factors contained in Section VI C of Implementing Order 3-22 and 3-41 indicate that a 9.87% SBE/Construction Subcontractor Goal is appropriate in the trades of masonry (2.76%), wood, plastic & composites (0.36%), finishes (1.09%), plumbing (3.58%), earthwork (1.13%) & specialties (.95%); AND a 6% SBE/Goods & Services Subcontractor Goal in the following areas: project photography, security/fencing, construction cleaning, shop drawings, scheduling/estimating, field surveying, temporary utilities, LEED Consulting, rental equipment/scaffolding, and trash/storage containers.
