The Master Plan is envisioned to update the Port's cargo, cruise, ferry, infrastructure, and commercial real estate development plans to create a sustainable and viable business model for PortMiami. The Master Plan must be based on sound market research, Port data, and the Port's partnering agreements to assist in providing a 5, 10, and 20-year forecast of port development as required by Section 331.14, of the Florida Statute.
