SCOPE OF WORK/DESCRIPTION: MIA's Stormwater runoff sampling and monitoring program is governed by permits issued by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP), and the South Florida Water Management District (SFWMD), DERM requirements must also be implemented. This project will include sampling and monitoring services for the Stormwater System to fulfill the sampling and reporting requirements mandated by these three agencies and update of the existing SFWMD permit. The Sampling Services shall include: Sampling events such as Monthly Background, Primary Storm and Investigative Reporting Services shall include: Conduct data analysis and laboratory coordination, prepare SFWMD annual and investigative reports. The teaming restrictions will be the following: Consultants electing to submit as a prime will be limited to participation on a single team and may not participate on any other team as a sub-consultant. Consultants electing to submit as a sub-consultant may only participate on three (3) teams. The testing laboratory services will be provided by the County.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: The consultant team is preferred to have experience in performing sampling and monitoring services for stormwater systems in accordance with relevant environmental permits and regulations. The team must present its experience in performing work similar to the advertised scope of work. The expertise must be met by a qualified individual(s) of the prime consultant firm(s), as applicable. The experience must be demonstrated by direct or substantial involvement of the individual(s) in a supervisory capacity at the Project Manager level or above. The determination of the individual's qualifications and compliance with the experience and qualifications and preference stipulations shall be at the sole discretion of the County.
