Kelly,

God afternoon, attached herewith is the memo you requested and copies of the previously forwarded attachments. I apologize, but after further reviewing the attachments, I noticed a "typo." Regarding the Community Workforce Program, we believe that this project, to be located within zip code 33035, doesn't apply.

Furthermore, I am hesitant to include the Soil Excavation, loading, hauling, and disposal line item for CSBE Goal considerations, because the excavation we are referring to includes the excavation of areas in very close proximity to environmentally sensitive lands and within Canal Right of Way. Both require experience and very close supervision.

As a compromise, I suggest "splitting" the line item - not physically, but just in a way that possibly could consider loading and hauling as CSBE tasks.

Good Afternoon Juan,

I've been assigned to review the subject project which you submitted to Veronica Clark yesterday. Please forward the signed cover memo which should be addressed to Jack Osterholt (see attached sample) so that it can be attached to your project package which will be posted on SBD's website. Please also provide the project's zip code. I'm attempting to ascertain whether or not it is within a Designated Target Area (DTA) for CWP applicability. If it is determined to be within a DTA, a breakdown of the total labor required, trades, and number of days associated with each will be requested. SBD would like to also include Line Item 10 (soil excavation, loading, hauling, and disposal) in the CSBE goal recommendation in addition to the line items referenced in your Attachment A of your submittal as we have certified firms which can perform this scope of work. Please advise if this will be possible or if there are any concerns with including this scope as well.
