Description of Project/Bid: Work on this contract includes but is not limited to: Milling & resurfacing, widening & resurfacing of intersecting streets up to the existing joint at the side street, or up to the Point of Curvature (PC) as determined by the Engineer, and/or the Plans, resurfacing of asphaltic pathways (pedestrian, bicycle, etc.) adjacent or not to the edge of pavement as necessary, temporary utility repairs (cold patches), clearing & excavating of shoulder areas or build-up, as per the Engineer; grading & clean-up of adjacent shoulders & removal of roots, required, pavement markings including - installation of reflective pavement markers (blue/blue) at fire hydrant locations, sidewalk, sidewalk cubs & connectors, and pedestrian ramps.
