The work consists of widening the existing roadway to a two-lane roadway with a striped center turn lane; sidewalks; curb and gutter; bike lanes; continuous storm drainage system;

pavement markings and signage; signal modifications; lighting; and landscaping.

An analysis of the factors contained in the project package, as well as the factors contained in Section VI.C. of Implementing Order 3-22 indicates that a 19.14% Small Business Enterprise – Construction (SBE-CONS) Subcontractor Goal is appropriate for this contract in the trades of: Poured Concrete Foundation and Structure Contractors (Concrete Work) – 10.77%, All Other Specialty Trade Contractors (Guardrail and fencing) – 0.78%, Electrical Contractors and Other Wiring Installation Contractors (Street Lighting) -5.90% and Painting and Wall Covering Contractors (Paving Marking and Signage Work) – 1.69%.
