PortMiami respectfully requests that the Division of Small Business Development (SBD) reevaluate Project No. 2017-001.01 - Berth 8 Environmental Mitigation, to assign Small Business Enterprise (SBE) and Community Workforce Program (CWP) measures, in order to proceed with the advertisement and subsequent bidding of the solicitation

Berth 8 Environmental Mitigation: The Work of this Contract comprises the tasks necessary for the removal, relocation, and monitoring of all scleractinia (hard) coral colonies and octocoral colonies (soft corals) from the existing rip rap or bulkhead at proposed Berth 8. The relocation site for most of the coral colonies is the existing gabion or new artificial reefs at artificial reef site. The coral species *Orbicella* spp., *Pseudodiploria* spp., and *Montastraea cavernosa* found on the existing rip rap or bulkhead shall be donated to the coral nursery at the Rosenstiel School of Marine and Atmospheric Science. The project consists of, but is not limited to, pre-construction coral surveying and monitoring; post-construction coral monitoring; and any supportive ancillary tasks to successfully complete all phases of the project. The Contractor will be required to obtain a Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission (FWC) Special Activity License for handling corals.

The construction cost estimate for this project is \$1,677,665.00, which includes 10% contingency.
