General Description of Work:

CONTRACTOR shall review all documents, specifications, plans and scope of work provided by Miami-Dade County Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department for Pelican Marina Boat Ramp Parking repairs. In general, this project includes but is not limited to; Site Demolition, Re-Construction and finish work of the Pelican Harbor Marina Boat Ramp Parking Lot Site, Onsite & Offsite Roadway Improvements including sidewalks, curb and gutter, striping, signage and signalization along SR934/N.E. 79th Street Causeway as shown in the construction documents, Accessible Concrete Walkways, Tree dispositions and relocations / Landscaping, Site Plumbing, Electrical work including: Site Lighting, service rack and associated conduits/equipment, Water main extension and installation of new Fire Hydrant with work further identified in the construction documents.

Estimated Total Value: \$2,023,645.00

Project Criteria:

This project contains FIND Grant monies that require the following:

- Full and open competitive bidding
- No State or Local Government Geographical Preferences

An analysis of the CSBE Program Ordinance 97-52, amended and I.O 3-22 has been conducted and the Department suggests a SBE-Cons **No-Measure** due to the grant funding requirements contained in the funding guidelines.
