We respectfully request that you review the attached recommendation for CSBE and SBE Construction goals.

Memorandum

MIAMIDADE

The Live Like Bella Park – New LEED Community Recreation Center is in compliance with the Miami-Dade Board of County Commissioners' directive that all new and major renovation construction projects must be designed and built to meet LEED Silver Certification. The requirement for this project is to be certified LEED Silver or better. As a result, it is imperative to have a Contractor that is experienced with LEED for New Construction and is committed to the successful achievement of LEED Silver. To support these goals the contractor must meet the minimum requirements as specified in order to be qualified to bid on this project.

The project scope in general includes but is not limited to: Contractor shall furnish all labor, equipment, and materials required for the partial demolition of the existing community building and conversion to a shelter; solar panel system; the construction of a new community center (to achieve a LEED Silver USGBC certification); a dedicated, memorial tree, re-striping of parking lot; new sidewalks; a covered loggia; trash container enclosure; and a kayak ramp/launch area, with further work identified in the contract documents. Additional information is referenced in the Contract Documents. This project has already been registered with the USGBC LEED-NC v2009 and the registration fee has been paid. The contractor will be responsible for all LEED construction and registration related costs and required for the pursuit of LEED. There are three Alternates: Alt. 1- Install Brick Pavers in walkways shown on sheet A101, in lieu of stamped concrete. Alt. 2 - Provide a solid surface counter top and backsplash (Sheet A505). Alt. 3 - Remove EWH1 & EWH2 from scope and install two (2) new tankless EWH.

Estimated Cost: \$2,563,140.00

Miami-Dade County Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department (PROS) is requesting that the General Contractor must have at least five years in business and that the Contractor must have successfully completed at least two (2) projects of similar size and scope within five years; one of which must have been certified LEED Silver or better. Contractor shall provide proof of the certification of LEED Silver or better by providing the actual documentation in the form of the award certificate or award notification from the USGBC.

Due to the specialized nature in the scope of the work, PROS respectfully requests that SBD consider a total 17.56% SBE Construction Goal including the following: 9.13% Site Work Sub-trades: Poured Concrete, Paving, Irrigation and Site Preparations as quantified on the Project Measure Analysis; 4.08% Plumbing, Heating and Air-Conditioning; 4.35% Electrical Contractors; and a 1.13 % SBE/G Goal for #67002 Bathroom Accessories and Water Cooler. PROS' believes that the identified sub-trade work can be performed by SBE Construction single trade firms without the required experience. The rest of the work will require the experience detailed above.
