Renovations will match the existing in-patient Nursing Unit below, which includes 24 Medical/Surgery single patient rooms of approximately 20,013 sq. feet. Renovations also includes major mechanical, electrical, and plumbing (MEP) work, fire protection, fire alarm, drywall, acoustical ceilings, flooring, new finishes including doors & hardware, and painting. Attempts were made to make this contract a Level 3 Set-Aside; however the Verification of Availability to Bid process resulted in only one (1) certified Level 3 General Contractor being able to meet all of the contract's requirements.
