SCOPE OF WORK/DESCRIPTION: Design/build and install a replacement Parking Access and Revenue Control System ("PARCS") to replace the current (legacy) parking system. This not-to-exceed, turn-key solution, will improve customer service, support the Parking Operator's management of the facility, improve efficiency and reduce reoccurring operating cost, and enhance revenue opportunities while enhancing revenue security. Contractor shall provide all hardware, software, tools, equipment, materials, labor, supervision, project management and all other items necessary or proper for, or incidental to, installing and maintaining an integrated PARCS at MIA. The Contractor warrants, for a period of one (1) year from the County's Final System Acceptance, that the Solution and all related components provided by the Contractor under the performance of this Agreement shall:

- Be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal use and remain in good working order, wear and tear excepted;
- Function properly and in conformity with the warranties in this Agreement;
- Meet the performance standards set forth in the Technical Manual and the Original Equipment Manufacture's published specifications.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: The successful proposer (Prime) is capable of demonstrating proven ability to perform a change-over of a PARCS system in a live operating environment, at an airport comparable in size and complexity to MIA during the last ten years. If the proposer is an individual or partnership, the individual and/or the partner, who shall be responsible for the operation of the Agreement, should have met the specified minimum qualifications. If the proposer is a Joint Venture, then at least one (1) of the Joint Venture Partners should satisfy all of the foregoing Minimum Qualifications. The Proposer, whether a joint venture or otherwise, may proffer the experience of its corporate parent, sister, or subsidiary ("an affiliated company") in meeting these minimum qualifications.
