### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Work under this Contract includes furnishing of all supervision, labor, materials, tools, equipment and performing all operations required for repairs to all 34 pier caps of the William Powell Bridge No. 874545 in accordance with the Contract Documents.

Work includes but is not limited to epoxy inject all cracks that measure between 0.010 and 0.50 inch wide at the surface of all existing concrete pier caps, notify if cracks wider than 0.50 inch are found, clean and apply penetrant sealant to all exposed concrete surfaces of all pier caps following epoxy injection repair of cracked areas. All work to be performed at nighttime.

If any changes are required due to conflict of design and or field conditions, the Engineer will make the final determination.

### Required Contractor's Certification:

At the time of Bid and pursuant to the requirements of Section 10-3 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida and these Solicitation and Contract Documents, the Bidder must hold a valid, current, and active:

Certificate of Competency from the County's Construction Trades Qualifying Board as a **Specialty Engineering Contractor**, commensurate to the requirements of the Scope of Work, in one or more engineering crafts to include structural engineering contractor. The specialty contractor shall subcontract with a qualified contractor any work which is incidental to the specialty but is specified in the aforementioned Code as being the work of other than that of the Engineering Specialty for which certified; or

Pursuant to Section 255.20, F.S. and in lieu of the above, the County may consider a bid from a Bidder that is a Contractor in good standing that has been prequalified and considered eligible by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) under Section 337.14, F.S. and Chapter 14-22, Florida Administrative Code, to perform the work described in the Contract Documents. Contractors seeking consideration under this Paragraph shall submit along with the Bid Documents for review and consideration, current copy(ies) of their FDOT Certificate(s) of Qualification, Certification of Work Underway, and Status of Contract(s) On Hand. Acceptable FDOT prequalification(s) necessary to perform the Work specified in the Contract Documents include the Minor Bridge Work Class or above.

### Experience Requirement:

The Bidder, through full time personnel employed by the Bidder, must demonstrate a minimum of five years of experience as the prime contractor in projects with scopes comparable to the Project Scope of Work. Demonstrate the experience requirement by including along with the bid submittal package a: **detailed description of completed projects, similar to the Project Scope of Work**, in which the Bidder is currently engaged or has completed **within the past ten (10) years**. List and describe those projects performed for government clients, similar size private entities, and any work performed for the County. The description should identify for each project (1) the name of the client/owner, (2) client/owner contact person and phone number for reference, (3) description of work, (4) total dollar value and duration of the contract, (5) statement or notation of whether Bidder is/was the prime contractor or subcontractor, and (6) the results of the project.

Pursuant to Section 255.20, F.S., the County may consider a bid from a Bidder in good standing, meeting the license requirements above, that has been **prequalified and considered eligible by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) under Section 337.14, F.S. and Chapter 14-2, Florida Administrative Code**, to perform the work described in the Contract Documents. Contractors seeking

consideration under this Paragraph shall submit along with the Bid Documents for review and consideration, current copy(ies) of their **FDOT Certificate(s) of Qualification in the Minor Bridge Work Class or higher, Certification of Work Underway, and Status of Contract(s) On Hand.**

Permits that are issued by the Public Works Department, Miami-Dade County for construction within the public right-of-way, as well as additional permits, which may be required by other municipalities or agencies, including those required for tree removal, will be the responsibility of the Contractor.
