Subject: Greynolds Park - New Playground RPQ. 131503-A; Project No. 220901-14-001

The Department is preparing to re-advertise the subject project and is respectfully requesting to re-bid as a MCC 7360- No Measure due to the special nature of the work for the installation of the playground equipment. To ensure the safety of those utilizing this large and specialized playground we must assure that this work is performed by experienced CPSI certified Contractors. The expired playground pool contract addressed this very matter. Since the contract had expired we initially bid the project through the MCC 7040 contract with the RPQ specifying the CPSI requirement. We did not intend for bidders to purchase compliance by subcontracting a certificate holder. It is essential that the certificate holder is an experienced playground contractor and that the company awarded have the requisite skills and experience to build the playground.

General Descriptions of Work:

Furnish all labor, equipment and materials required to: Clear, grub and compact sub grade throughout project area. Furnish root anchor safety stakes for the trees planted within the project area, stakes to be installed by others (Mix'ed Green, landscape contractor, NIC). Install concrete sidewalks, curbing, and sand. Furnish and install 2' of CU-Structural Soil™ throughout area delineated on plans. Install playground equipment, site furniture, and musical instruments. Install Engineered Wood Fiber (EWF) and Poured in Place rubber safety surface as specified on plans. Contractor shall furnish and install drinking fountain as specified on plans. Playground equipment, site furniture, musical instruments and EWF will be provided by Owner. Contractor shall pick up the items provided by the Owner at Construction and Maintenance Division yard, located at 11395 SW 79 St, Miami Florida 33173, with exception of EWF to be delivered to the site. Contractor shall coordinate delivery of EWF with Rep. Services and the delivery company for arrangements to stockpile on site as recommended by manufacturer to ensure successful installation. This is a rebid of RPQ 131503 with the Poured in Place Safety Surface added to the scope of work.

Estimated Value: \$326,184.70

Playground equipment and safety surface installation is approximately 52.2% of the entire Scope of Work.

Project Criteria:

The playground equipment installer must meet the following criteria:

- CPSI Certification held by Owner, principal or direct employee of the company actively engaged in the scope of work.
- Certified General Contractor.
- Successful completion of at least two comparable playgrounds within the last three years. Please require that the CSBE firms provide evidence of this experience; project names, dollar values, and contact information for verification purposes.
