The Department of Solid Waste Management (DSWM) respectfully requests that the Division of Small Business Development (SBD) re-evaluate RPQ No. 18297-22 Department of Solid Waste Management's (DSWM) Central Transfer Station Tipping Floor Project - Phase II to assign a Small Business Enterprise-Construction (SBE-CON) measure to proceed with the advertisement and subsequent bidding of the solicitation under the 7360 Miscellaneous Construction Contract.

Scope of Services:

DSWM requires services to complete specialized tipping floor construction services at the DSWM's Central Transfer Station.

The project contains options that may be exercised at the sole discretion of DSWM.
