Description of Project/Bid: To establish a contract that includes but is not limited to the following: Milling and resurfacing, widening and resurfacing of intersecting streets, resurfacing of asphaltic pathways (pedestrian, bicycle, etc.) adjacent or not to the edge of pavement as necessary, temporary utility repairs (cold patches), clearing and excavating of shoulder areas or build-up, as directed by the Engineer; grading and clean-up of adjacent shoulders and removal of roots, as required, pavement markings including the installation of reflective pavement markers (blue/blue) at fire hydrant locations, sidewalk, curb and gutter, connectors, and pedestrian ramps.
