

Subject: Request for SBD Placement on Review Committee
MDT 7360 Miscellaneous Construction Plan Project
Parking Space Counters @ Metrorail Garages - RPQ No. 294742

It is recommended that Internal Services / Small Business Development (SBD) place the Miami-Dade Transit (MDT) referenced project on the agenda for the next Review Committee (RC) meeting.

MDT's Office of Civil Rights, Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE) program, has recommended a 0% DBE project goal, and has provided the applicable DBE requirements based on scope of services and project workload. No SBD measures or Community Work-Force program requirements are recommended because this project is 100% federally or State funded and will be advertised under the terms and conditions of the 7360 Miscellaneous Construction Plan. As such, MDT is requesting to proceed with bid advertisement.

Scope of Work: Installation of real-time parking space counting systems at five (5) of its largest parking garages, located at Dadeland South, Dadeland North, South Miami, Earlington Heights and Okeechobee Metrorail Stations. The available space counting systems will allow Metrorail customers to check real-time parking availability over the Internet using personal electronic devices including Smart phones, Personal Digital Assistants (PDAs), Tablets, etc., and by Electronic Signs located at the entrances to each of the five (5) garages. The system shall provide LOT FULL notification when all available spaces are occupied.

The contractor shall supply power at all required AC and DC supply power locations at required equipment operating voltage for newly installed equipment, and comply with all applicable Compendium of Design Criteria, NFPA NEC and local code requirements.

Budget Estimate: \$1,800,000.00
