Subject: Request for SBD Placement on Review Committee
MDT 7360 Miscellaneous Construction Plan Project
Park and Ride Facility at Kendall and SW 127th Avenue - RPQ No. 306670

It is recommended that Internal Services / Small Business Development (SBD) place the Miami-Dade Transit (MDT) referenced project on the agenda for the next Review Committee (RC) meeting.

MDT's Office of Civil Rights, Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE) program, has recommended a 0% DBE project goal, and has provided the applicable DBE requirements based on scope of services and project workload. No SBD measures or Community Work-Force program requirements are recommended because this project is 100% federally or State funded and will be advertised under the terms and conditions of the 7360 Miscellaneous Construction Plan. As such, MDT is requesting to proceed with bid advertisement.

Scope of Work: The proposed Park and Ride Facility involves constructing approximately 183 parking spaces for MDT's bus patrons, constructing a proposed "Only Bus" concrete driveway for MOT's buses to be able to drop-off and pick-up passengers, furnishing and installing three (3) proposed bus shelters, milling and repaving existing streets along the sides of the proposed parking lots of the referenced Park and Ride Facility, drainage improvements, installing proposed light poles, installing traffic signs, and installing pavement markings.

Budget Estimate: \$1,540,000.00



Miami-Dade Transit is preparing a solicitation for the construction of a park and ride at Kendall and SW 127th Avenue. The cost for the construction of the above-captioned project is estimated to be approximately \$1,540,000.00. This project will be funded by: The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT).


The scope of this project consists of, but is not limited to: the construction of approximately 183 parking spaces for patrons, concrete driveway for buses, furnishing and installing three (3) proposed bus shelters, milling and repaving existing streets along the sides of the proposed parking lots, draining improvements, installing light poles, traffic signs, and pavement markings.

After a review of the scope of work, this office recognizes that this project presents a premium opportunity for a race-neutral application for DBEs who by reason of their certification are ready, willing, and able to provide the services requested on each item in the scope of work. Moreover, our office sees that this project provides an excellent opportunity for a DBE firm, or other small business to competitively compete for this as a Prime contractor.

It is recommended that a DBE goal not be assigned to this project; however, ISD may still assign a local measure/ preference provided there are no restrictions.
