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We respectfully request that you consider our recommendation for a SBE-Cons No-Measure.

**Description of Work:**

Furnish and install approximately 500 linear feet of existing chain link fence along the North Bound & South Bound property lines of DTPW South Busway damaged by hurricane Irma.

**Projection Location:**

South Busway from SW 160 Street to SW 232 Street

**Estimated Total Value:**

\$38,849.00

**Project Criteria:**

The project contains Federal (FEMA) and Grant monies that require the following:

- Full and open competitive bidding
- No State or Local Government Geographical Preferences
- David Bacon wages are not applicable to this FEMA Public Assistance Program

An analysis of the CSBE Program Ordinance 97-52, amended and I.O 3-22 has been conducted and the Department suggest a SBD-Cons No-Measure due to the Federal requirements contained in the funding guidelines. The Department further suggests using the 7360 contract to be able to conform to Federal requirements.
