The project was advertised before as RPQ No.376954 Miscellaneous Construction Contract (MCC) CICC 7040-0/07 Plan and has been cancelled due to only one bid was received, contained substantial higher prices, and the deficit of qualified CSBE Contractors under Miscellaneous Construction Contract MCC 7040 Plan to perform the majority of the Scope of Work.

**Required Contractor's Certification:**

At the time of Bid and pursuant to the requirements of Section 10-3 of the Code of Miami- Dade County, Florida, the Bidder must hold a valid, current, and active:

1. State of Florida Certified General Contractor License, a General Building Contractor License, or a Building Contractor License as required by the Florida Building Code, for the types of Work covered by the Contract at the time of RPQ submission and maintain same throughout the duration of the project.
2. The State of Florida Construction Industry Licensing Board, pursuant to the provisions of Section 489.115 of the Florida Statute and registered with the Miami-Dade County, Building Department or,
3. The Dade County Construction Trades Qualifying Board, pursuant to the provisions of Section 10-3(a) of the County Code. Holders of Miami-Dade County Certificates of Competency must also hold Certificates of Registration issued by the State of Florida Construction Licensing Board, pursuant to the provisions of Section 489.115 or Section 489.117 of the Florida Statutes.

**Experience Requirement:**

The Bidder must demonstrate that it has full-time personnel with the necessary experience performing railroad maintenance services to perform the Project's Scope of Work. This experience shall include work in successfully completed projects performed with:

- Minimum of 15 years in business,
- Must have experience in Transit project within the last 5 years
- Must have experience working in heavy Transit within the last 5 years

Demonstrate the experience requirement by:

Providing a detailed description of at least three (3) projects similar in detail to the Project's Scope of Work described in these Solicitation Documents and in which the Bidder's identified personnel is currently engaged or has completed within the past five years. - F. Statement or notation of whether Bidder's referenced personnel is/was employed by the prime contractor or subcontractor, and

G. For completed projects, provide letters of certification of final acceptance or similar project closure documentation issued by the client and available Contractor's performance evaluations.
