We respectfully request that you consider our recommendation for a SBE-Cons No-Measure.

General Description of Work:

Contractor shall furnish all labor, equipment and materials required for Hurricane Irma repairs at Hobie Beach and Virginia Key: Excavate and dispose of DAMAGED elements including but not limited to pavers, compacted fill, concrete curbs, rock revetment, and geotextile filter fabric. Excavated pavers and rock revetment in good condition shall be neatly stacked for reuse. Restore excavated damaged areas to conditions depicted in plans, and as per permits and typical details with further work identified in the contract documents for RPQ: HI – 185430, Project: 422003-18-001.

Estimated Total Value: \$3,070,000.00

Project Criteria:

This project contains Federal Grant monies that require the following:

- Full and open competitive bidding
- No State or Local Government Geographical Preferences
- Davis Bacon wages are not applicable to this FEMA Public Assistance Program
