2.1 PURPOSE

The purpose of this solicitation is to establish a contract for the purchase of scuba, skin diving equipment and repair parts for various Miami Dade County departments. Section 4 Bid Submittal Form contains but is not limited to a listing of the items required for this solicitation.

The contract will consist of two categories as specified below:

1. Category "A" - Scuba & Skin Diving Equipment
2. Category "B" - Water Rescue Equipment

2.2 SMALL BUSINESS CONTRACT MEASURES (Bid Preference)

Refer to Section 1, General Terms and Conditions, Subsection 1.43, Small Business Enterprises Measures

2.3 TERM OF CONTRACT FIVE (5) YEARS

This contract shall commence on the first calendar day of the month succeeding approval of the contract by the Board of County Commissioners, or designee, unless otherwise stipulated in the Notice of Award Letter which is distributed by the County's Internal Services Department (ISD) Procurement Management Division; and contingent upon the completion and submittal of all required bid documents. The contract shall expire on the last day of the last month of the contract term.

2.4 OPTION TO RENEW FOR FIVE (5) ADDITIONAL YEAR(S) (With Price Adjustment)

Prior to, or upon completion of, the initial contract term of five (5) years, the County shall have the option to renew this contract for an additional five (5) year period.

The initial contract prices resultant from this solicitation shall prevail for a one (1) year period from the contract's initial effective date. Prior to completion of each one year period of the contract, the County may consider an adjustment to price effective the next contract year based on changes in the following pricing index: Greater Miami, Ft. Lauderdale area All Urban Consumers All Items.

It is the vendor's responsibility to request any pricing adjustment under this provision. The vendor's request for adjustment must be submitted 90 days prior to expiration of the then current contract year. The vendor adjustment request cannot be in excess of the relevant pricing index change. If no adjustment request is received from the vendor, the County will assume that the vendor has agreed to maintain the then current pricing. Any adjustment request received after the annual contract anniversary date will only be considered for the following contract year.

The County reserves the right to negotiate lower pricing for the option to renew term based

on market research information or other factors that influence price. The County reserves the right to apply any reduction in pricing for the option to renew term based on the downward movement of the applicable index.

The County reserves the right to reject any price adjustments submitted by the vendor and/or to not exercise any otherwise available option period based on such price adjustments. Continuation of the contract beyond the initial period, and any option subsequently exercised, is a County prerogative, and not a right of the vendor.

This prerogative will be exercised only when such continuation is clearly in the best interest of the County.

2.5 METHOD OF AWARD TO PRIMARY & SECONDARY BIDDER BY GROUP

Award of this contract will be made to the primary and secondary lowest priced responsive, responsible Bidder on a group by group basis. To be considered for award by group, the Bidder shall offer prices for all items within a given group.

The County will then select the Bidder for award for each group by totaling either the unit prices for all of the items within each group, or if so structured, by totaling the extended pricing for each item within each group. If a vendor fails to submit an offer for all items within the group, its offer for that specific group will be rejected.

While the method of award prescribes the method for determining the lowest responsive, responsible vendor, the County will award this contract to the designated lowest vendor as the primary vendor and will award this contract to the designated second lowest vendor as the secondary vendor respectively. If the County exercises this right, the primary vendor shall have the primary responsibility to initially perform the service or deliver the goods identified in this contract. If the primary vendor fails to perform it may be terminated for default and the County shall have the option to seek the identified goods or services from the secondary vendor. During the term of the contract, the County may also make award to the third lowest vendor as tertiary if the primary and secondary vendors do not perform.

Award to multiple vendors is made for the convenience of the County and does not exempt the primary vendor from fulfilling its contractual obligations. Failure of any vendor to perform in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contract may result in the vendor being deemed in breach of contract. The County may terminate the contract for default and charge the vendor re-procurement costs, if applicable.

2.6 "EQUAL" PRODUCT CAN BE CONSIDERED UPON RECEIPT OF SPECIFIED DATA

The manufacturer's name, brand name and/or model number information contained in this Solicitation are being used for the sole purpose of establishing the minimum requirement of level of quality, standard of performance, and design and is in no way intended to prohibit the offer of another manufacturer's items of equal material unless otherwise indicated on the Bid/Proposal Submission Form.

This specific Solicitation requires submission of the following documentation to enable County evaluation of "equal" products:

If an "equal" product may be considered by the County in accordance with the Bid/Proposal Submission Form, the unit shall be equal in quality and standards of performance to the item specified in the Solicitation. Where an "or equal" item is offered, and product information sheets are required, the initial offer must be accompanied with two (2) complete sets of product information sheets (such as factory specifications, standard manufacturer information sheets, catalogues, and brochures), and if required, two (2) copies of performance test results of the unit offered as an equal. Also for product information submittals, all supporting documentation submitted by the offeror must in total meet the required specifications set forth in this Solicitation. Where the standard product literature submitted with the offer provides information that does not comply with the specifications, the offeror shall state, in an official letter on corporate letterhead as part of their initial offer, the differences between the item they are specifically offering, and the equipment described by the standard product literature, to substantiate compliance to all of the specifications set forth in this Solicitation. In such cases, any offer submitted with standard product literature but without the letter explaining compliance will result in the rejection of the offer for not meeting the Bid Solicitation specifications.

If samples of all "or equal" items bid are required for evaluation, such items are to be provided at no cost to the County, and should be submitted with the initial offer, or at the time of specific request. Failure to meet this requirement may result in your offer being rejected.

For "equal" products to be evaluated based on submission of product labels, the initial offer should be accompanied with labels indicating the specification and ingredients for each "or equal" item offered. Failure to meet this requirement may result in your offer being rejected.

The County shall be sole judge of equality, based on the best interests of the County, and its decision in this regard shall be final. Items labeled "No Substitute" on the County's Bid/Proposal Submission Form are the only products that will be accepted under this Bid Solicitation.

2.9 DELIVERY SHALL BE (5) DAYS AFTER DATE OF ORDER

The vendor shall make deliveries within five (5) business days after the date of the order. All deliveries shall be made in accordance with good commercial practice and all required delivery timeframes shall be adhered to by the vendor(s); except in such cases where the delivery will be delayed due to acts of nature, strikes, or other causes beyond the control of the vendor. In these cases, the vendor shall notify the County of the delays in advance of the original delivery date so that a revised delivery schedule can be appropriately considered by the County. All products submitted must be in the original manufacturers packaging.

Should the vendor(s) to whom the contract(s) is awarded fail to deliver in the number of days stated above, the County reserves the right to cancel the contract on a default basis after any back order period that has been specified in this contract has lapsed. If the contract is so terminated, it is hereby understood and agreed that the County has the authority to purchase the goods elsewhere and to charge the incumbent vendor with any re-procurement costs. If the vendor fails to honor these re-procurement costs, the County may terminate the contract for default.

Certain County employees may be authorized in writing to pick-up materials under this contract. Vendors shall require presentation of this written authorization. The vendor shall maintain a copy of the authorization. If the vendor is in doubt about any aspect of material pick-up, vendor shall contact the appropriate user department to confirm the authorization.

A. PACKING SLIP/DELIVERY TICKET TO ACCOMPANY ITEMS DURING DELIVERY:

The successful bidder shall enclose a complete packing slip or delivery ticket with any items to be delivered in conjunction with this Solicitation. The packing slip shall be attached to the shipping carton(s) which contain the items and shall be made available to the County's authorized representative during delivery. The packing slip or delivery ticket shall include, at a minimum, the following information: purchase order number; date of order; a complete listing of items being delivered; and backorder quantities and estimated delivery of backorders if applicable.
