

Christmas Tree Recycling 2015

Beginning Saturday, December 26, 2015, residents who receive curbside waste collection service from Miami-Dade County can recycle their Christmas trees by taking them to one of the County's Trash and Recycling Centers* or the West Miami-Dade Home Chemical Collection Center listed below:

(Trash and Recycling Centers: open 7 days a week, 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.)

West Miami-Dade - 8801 N.W. 58 Street

(Home Chemical Collection Center: open 7 days a week for tree drop off only, from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. through Jan. 8, normal hours and days thereafter)

ALL TREES BROUGHT FOR RECYCLING MUST BE FREE OF TREE STANDS, LIGHTS, ORNAMENTS, TINSEL AND OTHER DECORATIONS.

Christmas Tree Mulch Availability

Christmas tree mulch will be available at the following six locations beginning in early February 2016 on a first-come, first-served basis, while supplies last.

West Perrine - 16651 S.W. 107 Ave.	Sunset Kendall - 8000 S.W. 107 Ave.
Eureka Drive - 9401 S.W. 184 St.	West Little River - 1830 N.W. 79 St.
Moody Drive - 12970 S.W. 268 St.	North Dade - 21500 N.W. 47 Ave.

Please bring your own shovel and bag or container to take mulch away.

Residents who choose not to drop off their Christmas tree have the following two options:

1. Cut the tree into smaller pieces and place it in your green waste cart for collection on any of your regularly scheduled waste collection days. The tree must fit entirely inside the waste cart. Trees placed next to the waste cart cannot be collected by the automated vehicle.
2. If you cannot cut your tree into pieces and place it in your green waste cart, the tree may be placed at the curbside **by Friday, January 8, 2016**, and it will be picked up. Christmas trees placed at the curbside after this date will not be picked up and must either be dropped off or placed in the green waste cart for collection as described above.
