**1. CHERRY GROVE TRUST, LLC
F/K/A: JOSE MILTON, TRUSTEE (07-111)**

Location: 9048 SW 97 Avenue, Miami-Dade County, Florida (7.78 Acres)

The applicant is requesting a zone change from neighborhood business district to limited apartment house district on parcel "A", and on parcels "A" and "B" to permit the following: Modifications of a paragraph of a covenant and of a condition of a previous resolution to allow the applicant to submit revised plans showing additional property and two new 2 and 3 story apartment buildings added to the previously approved multi-family residential development, to permit an apartment building setback to be less than required from property line, and to permit accompanying requests, on this site.

2. YURI AND CARMEN SUCART (07-142)

Location: 8445 SW 94 Street, Miami-Dade County, Florida (129.57' X 300.77')

The applicants are requesting a zone change from single-family one acre estate district to single-family modified estate district, to permit a single-family residence setback to be less than required from property line, to waive subdivision regulations requiring parcels to have frontage on a public street, also requesting to permit an accompanying request(s), on this site.

3. ROGER & DOROTHY WOLIN (07-172)

Location: 7677 Ponce de Leon Road, Miami-Dade County, Florida
(1.24 Gross Acres)

The applicants are requesting a zone change from single-family one acre estate district to single-family suburban estate district, or in the alternative, the applicants are requesting to permit two lots with less lot areas than required, and with either of the above requests, to permit two lots each with less frontage than required, also requesting to permit an accompanying request(s), on this site.

4. HIRCIO JAVIER BARRIOS (07-199)

Location: 8545 SW 68 Street Road, Miami-Dade County, Florida (0.88 Acre)

The applicant is requesting to permit the storage of a boat with length and width greater than permitted, on this site.

5. BRIAN & AMALIA POWELL (07-254)

Location: 7272 SW 53 Avenue, Miami-Dade County, Florida (75' X 125')

The applicants are requesting to permit a single-family residence setbacks to be less than required from property lines, and to permit a greater lot coverage than allowed, on this site.

Multiple members of individual community councils may be present.

All persons are entitled to attend and to speak at zoning hearings. However, the courts have ruled that it is improper to contact a Board member individually, either orally or in writing, about zoning applications.

Those items not heard prior to the ending time for this meeting, will be deferred to the next available zoning hearing meeting date for this Board.
