The agenda will include, but is not limited to: Department of Planning and Zoning – Public Works Department will discuss issues re: Intersection of 57th Ave & 195th where county staff will contact the principal of the school in regards to the stacking on 195th drive, School signs and drainage on 195th drive, Visible Road markers on 75th Place, Honey Hill Drive traffic calming studies with the information provided my MDPD and Street Re-pavement projects in Community Council 5 Area; Public Works Department, Transit & FDOT will discuss issues re: Intersection of Miami Gardens Drive & 87th Ave traffic, bus stacking and the re-pavement project of Miami Gardens Drive; Resolution regarding the Country Club/Palm Springs North Charrette (Town Center); Miami-Dade Parks Dept – Norma & Jean Reach Park (maintenance) & Acadia Park (bathrooms), Recreation Activities during Summer Break involving outside agencies; Miami-Dade Police – Crime Statistics over the summer break; Mobile Operation Center will be available at next meeting.
