**PUBLIC HEARING ON OCTOBER 2008 CYCLE
CDMP AMENDMENT APPLICATION**

Mr. Patrick Moore, DP&Z, presented the council with the CDMP application No. 2 in which Miami-Dade Aviation Department requested to revise the text relating to non-aviation uses and modify airport land use master plans for Miami International Airport, Opa-Locka Executive Airport and Kendall-Tamiami Executive Airport.

This particular meeting was regarding more specifically the Kendall-Tamiami Airport due to the fact that it is located within the Council's Kendall area. Miami-Dade Aviation Department's request is for the text of the Land Use Element, section title "Transportation" on pages I-54 and I-55 of the Adopted Components of the CDMP, to be revised in order for the CDMP to be internally consistent.

Mr. Moore stated Planning and Zoning Department's recommendation as to adopt and transmit the application at hand. Such application is scheduled to go before the Planning Advisory Board on April 27, 2009; and before the BCC in October 2009 for a final hearing.

Subsequent to the community input and questions from the Councils, the West Kendall Community Council (11) passed a resolution to "adopt/approve and transmit" the application. The resolution was motioned by Vice-Chair Wander and seconded by Councilman Diaz. The Motion passed with a 7-0 vote.
