What is a Pre-application Meeting?

- A part of an applicants due diligence process
- An opportunity for an applicant and staff from all County reviewing agencies to meet and discuss a proposed development, prior to submitting a formal application
- A time for applicants to ask questions regarding standards and regulations

Why a pre-application meeting?

- To improve the development review process
- For accountability by both the development community and County staff
- Affords an applicant the opportunity to meet with all reviewing agency staff simultaneously
- Applicant receives input from all reviewing agencies and pertinent information for the submittal of a complete formal zoning application
- To reduce the need for multiple submittals during the formal hearing review process and to get a development approval expeditiously




What type of Applications?

Pre-application will be required for the following:

- All Developmental Impact Committee(DIC)
- Administrative Site Plan Review (ASPR)
- Modification to Resolution and/or Covenant, if in conjunction with a Site Plan
- Public hearings, except individual single-family residential lots and others as determined by Development Services





When are meetings?

- Meetings will be <u>every</u>
 Thursday
- Meetings will be scheduled between 2:00 and 4:30
- Each meeting will be 30 minutes in duration
- Applications must be received at least 5 working days prior to the desired Thursday meeting date



What do I submit?

- A. Pre-Application Meeting Request Form
- B. Written Statement
- C. Prior Zoning Approvals
- D. Proposed Site Plan
- E. Traffic Information
- F. Any questions and issues to be discussed at the meeting



What happens at the Pre-Application Meeting?

- Applicant will present an overview of the proposed development
- A representative from reviewing agencies will be present at the preapplication meeting
- Applicants can ask questions of staff
- Applicant will be provided with checklists and comments relevant to the proposed development
- Comments and checklist will be complete at time of pre-application meeting; however, they may be revised as a result of the meeting



Next Steps

- After the Pre-Application meeting, a formal letter with all agency comments, checklists and contact information will be provided to the applicant within 2 business days
- If necessary the applicant may schedule additional meetings with any reviewing agency



 File a formal zoning application, be sure to include all pre-application documents Shorten the development review time, while improving the quality of the review by professional staff
