It will also touch on Internal Affairs investigations in small departments, correctional facilities, and other related topics.



SOCIAL MEDIA AND OPEN-SOURCE INVESTIGATIONS

TACTICAL LIFE SAVER - TLS

This course is designed to teach law enforcement officers the time critical skills needed to manage life threatening bleeding as well as airway management in situations that are unsafe for civilian EMS.

If you are ever shot or stabbed, you had better know how to control the bleeding. Lose too much blood and you will be dead in a few short minutes. You don't have time to wait on EMS - you must care for yourself. That's where this training comes in.

Surviving a gunfight may come down to how quickly you can properly apply a tourniquet to a wounded limb and get back in the fight. Yes, neutralizing the threat is a component of your survival, but if you've taken rounds your fight for life may have just started.

Here at the Miami-Dade Public Safety Training Institute & Research Center, we are amongst the nation's law enforcement pioneers offering a 40-hour course titled Tactical Life Saver (TLS). The course uses lecture, live-fire and force-on-force exercises to teach the basic skills you need in the field to stop your attacker and keep yourself alive until EMS can evac you to a trauma center.

This course is physically demanding. Students should bring tactical attire or training clothing that can be damaged or torn.





FUNDAMENTAL TECHNIQUES AND METHODOLOGY FOR DOCUMENTING CRIME SCENES

April 29 - May 1 | \$760

LOCATION: Miami-Dade Public Safety Training Institute

& Research Center

HOTEL: InterContinental at Doral Miami, \$185 Single/Double

The purpose of this 3-day workshop is to introduce the attendees to successful documentation of crime scenes. Attendees will be able to discuss, report, and apply techniques to the documentation of crime scenes through photographic and sketching methodology. Attendees will utilize photographic methods using various lighting techniques, and measurement techniques to demonstrate size as well as hand-crafted sketches and 3D technology programs for documenting crime scenes.

UNDERWATER POLICE SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY

May 13 - 24 | \$1900

LOCATION: Miami-Dade Public Safety Training Institute

& Research Center

HOTEL: InterContinental at Doral Miami, \$185 Single/Double

This 2-week course is open to all officers assigned to a dive team in an official capacity within a criminal justice agency. Officers not assigned to a dive team in an official capacity may attend this course; however, their participation must be approved in advance by their agency and the Training Institute Director.

Prior to entering this course, participants must possess current certifications and email the copies to the coordinator of the following:

- Advanced Open Water SCUBA Diver
- First Aid/CPR/AED
- Oxygen Provider Certification
- A Medical Statement Form must be completed by each participant

The course will combine classroom instruction with practical in-water application. The student will participate in the removal of vehicles from lakes, rock pits, and canals. Students will also search the hull of a freighter at the Port of Miami and participate in helocasting exercises. The student will be exposed to underwater search and recovery, underwater video and photography, underwater crime scene processing and the use of underwater lift bags. This is a salary incentive course for Florida officers. Students must provide a letter from their department stating if they are taking the course for Salary Incentive or Mandatory Re-Training credit.

ADVANCED AUTO CRIMES INVESTIGATIONS

May 20 - 24 | \$910

LOCATION: City of Doral Police Training Center HOTEL: InterContinental at Doral Miami, \$185 Single/Double

This advanced level course is designed for Auto Crimes Investigators and combines classroom instruction with practical exercises daily. INTRODUCTION TO BLOODSTAIN PATTERN ANALYSIS ON FABRICS AND DIGITAL CASEWORK

June 10 - 14 | \$1275

LOCATION: Miami-Dade Public Safety Training Institute

& Research Center

HOTEL: InterContinental at Doral Miami, \$140 Single/Double

This course will teach the participants about the composition and construction of natural and synthetic fibers, construction of yarns, construction of fabrics, and the effect these variables have on the formation and appearance of bloodstains when liquid blood is deposited on these materials.

Instruction will be delivered through, lectures, readings, discussion, and laboratory practical's involving liquid blood, fabric, and clothing. Participants will learn how to examine, document, preserve, and write reports for bloodstained fabrics and clothing.

In addition, participants will learn how to evaluate BPA cases that are provided in a digital format. The workshop is limited to 16 participants that have previously attended a minimum of a 40-hour basic Bloodstain Pattern Analysis Workshop.



CRIME PREVENTION AND COMMUNITY POLICING

July 15 - 17 | \$765

LOCATION: City of Doral Police Training Center HOTEL: InterContinental at Doral Miami, \$129 Single/Double

The Community Oriented Policing (COP) concept is an intricate part of police work that is often undervalued for its importance in problem-solving and crime prevention within a community. A collaborate partnership between law enforcement and a community can significantly improve the quality of life within a community by proactive problem-solving; and community engagement to address the causes of crime, fear of crime, and other community issues.

This course will provide a foundation for officers to build partnerships with communities; transitioning from traditional policing to community policing. Students will be educated on the history and development of community policing, the fundamental elements of police and community partnerships and its implications. In-class problem-solving scenarios will also be conducted utilizing the nationally excepted Scanning Analysis Response Assessment (SARA) model. Proficiency and understanding of the SARA model will be demonstrated through group and individual presentations. Finally, students will show their understanding of community policing and crime prevention through role-playing scenarios.



RISK PROTECTION ORDER: PREPARATION AND PROCEDURES

July 29 - 30 | \$650

This course is designed to educate the law enforcement officer, detective, or civilian police legal employee, regarding the preparation, submission, and execution of Risk Protection Orders (RPO). The course will provide an understanding as to the RPO's origin, as it relates to mass casualty incidents, explain the criteria to obtain the order, as well as the procedures following approval by the courts. The attendee will learn to investigate the incident and the individual, in order to build their case prior to petitioning the courts for the RPO. 


HIGH PROFILE MURDER CASE SYMPOSIUM

The curriculum will cover Mail Fraud, Contractor Fraud, Sovereign Citizens, Squatters, Medical Fraud, Credit Card Fraud, Cargo Theft, Workman's Compensation Fraud, Insurance Fraud, Condo Fraud, Deed Fraud, Mortgage and Real Estate Fraud, Organized Retail Theft and other critical topics relevant to fraud investigators.



HOMICIDE INVESTIGATIONS

FINGERPRINTING TECHNIQUES, EVALUATION AND ANALYSIS OF FINGERPRINT EVIDENCE

HOTEL: InterContinental at Doral Miami, \$142 Single/Double

This 40-hour workshop is designed to introduce crime scene and law enforcement personnel on how to properly fingerprint crime scenes and effectively collect evidence. The first portion of this workshop (first 3 days/24 hours) will introduce attendees to analyze and evaluate fingerprint lifts. The second portion of this workshop (last 2 days/16 hours) will introduce attendees to the history, physiology, analysis and the evaluation process of those lifted fingerprints.

Other course objectives include instructing students on how to lift fingerprints from different surface types, while utilizing the most effective techniques. Several fingerprinting techniques will be discussed, examined and utilized. The attendees will then be introduced to how fingerprints are evaluated and analyzed, and how that relates to the outcome of a criminal investigation. Attendees will analyze and evaluate their own fingerprint lifts in the second portion of this course.

This workshop will be taught by crime scene personnel and latent examiners, in order to provide a well-rounded course outcome.

ADMINISTRATION AND LEADERSHIP ACADEMY FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT CIVILIANS

This workshop is designed as an advanced learning experience for civilian law enforcement employees seeking to build their administrative and leadership competencies. Civilians are a growing segment of the law enforcement community. They have increasing importance in the administration of law enforcement agencies and the management of personnel. This 3-day academy provides intensive, efficient instruction, to help civilian leaders elevate their potential and hone their skills as reliable and trusted public safety professionals.

Attendees who complete this workshop will:

FEMALE INVOLVEMENT IN VIOLENT ENCOUNTERS (F.I.V.E.) - ENHANCED

October 14 - 18 | \$870

LOCATION: Miami-Dade Public Safety Training Institute

& Research Center

HOTEL: InterContinental at Doral Miami, \$160 Single/Double

This course is specifically designed to enhance the student's skills in the fundamentals of building searches. This course will also outline and execute the tactical techniques associated with ballistic shields and identify various mechanical and ballistic breaching tools. Students will be challenged mentally, physically, and professionally in handling high risk and stressful situations that an officer may face in the performance of her duties.

On the last day, all students will apply and execute the different techniques and skills learned throughout the training by participating in a real-life scenario where they will engage in a dangerous encounter with combative subjects. Training will be accentuated into a realistic course by the use of live fire, non-lethal training simunitions, and close-quarters combat to enhance the officer's skills needed to control violent subjects. These exercises will produce a physical and stressful element to simulate psychological and physiological effects of a potentially lethal confrontation. Students are expected to build awareness and have the confidence to confront the everyday challenges faced throughout their career.

Note: Long sleeve shirts and gloves are recommended due to force-onforce live simunition training.



AUTO THEFT SYMPOSIUM

October 21 - 25 | \$855

LOCATION: City of Doral Police Training Center **HOTEL:** InterContinental at Doral Miami, \$160 Single/Double

This course is designed to cover all types of auto theft related crimes and benefit novice and experienced auto theft investigators from both large and small departments, as well as regional task forces. There will be sessions on VIN history/breakdown, VIN number locations, altered VINs, truck and tractor identification, motorcycle identification, vessel identification, title fraud, fraudulent purchases, export investigations, and resources for investigations, including NMVTIS, NICB, and more.

Additionally, there will be hands-on sessions involving restoration of altered VINs and inspection of recovered stolen altered vehicles.



CRIME SCENE PHOTOGRAPHY WORKSHOP

The purpose of this 3-day workshop is to introduce the many challenges facing crime scene personnel and law enforcement personnel in documenting crime scenes through photographic techniques and how to overcome these challenges.

Scene photography, alternate light source photography and working in low lit situations will be addressed. PowerPoint lectures and many hands-on practicum's will be provided to all those attending in order to achieve these objectives.

Attendees must bring departmental issued camera equipment and tripods and wear comfortable but appropriate clothing. Basic camera knowledge is desired but not mandatory.



RED DOT PISTOL TRANSITION

November 18 - 19 | \$900

In the Red Dot Pistol Transition course, students will be introduced and trained how to properly employ a Red Dot Sight (RDS) on a duty pistol. This skill will be of great value to the individual officer and employing agency by improving speed of sight acquisition and target accuracy. Students will learn the proper maintenance and care of setting up and maintaining the RDS on their duty pistol, finding the dot on presentation of pistol, low light shooting with RDS, marksmanship, and movement drills with RDS.

BURIED BODY AND SURFACE SKELETON WORKSHOP

December 9 - 13 | \$875

This 40-hour course is designed for crime scene investigators, detectives, crime laboratory analysts and others in the field of forensic science, that need the basic training and techniques for buried body or surface skeleton crime scene examination and recovery. The attendees will have a working knowledge of the techniques required to properly process clandestine gravesites, examine a surface skeleton and a buried body crime scene, and to recognize human remains through the use of skeletal anatomy. They will be provided with insight into the use of good forensic archeological techniques in the documentation, photography, sketching, and searching of clandestine graves. They will also be provided with a list of minimum and desirable tools to be used in the investigation of clandestine gravesites and shown how to properly excavate the site with minimal disturbance to the evidence at the scene. Lastly, students will receive instruction on the collection of entomological evidence, insight on the use of cadaver dogs in locating human remains at suspected gravesites, insight as to the capabilities of forensic artists in the facial reconstruction of human remains for later identification, informed on the capabilities of forensic odontology, and case presentation experience.
