Failure to acknowledge receipt of all addenda may be cause for disqualification.

#### CHANGES TO PROCUREMENT REQUIREMENTS:

A. Changes to Invitation to Bid: At the Comments section delete the License Requirements and Experience and replace it with the following:

#### LICENSE REQUIREMENTS:

Certificate of Competency Requirement:

- 1. At the time of Bid and pursuant to the requirements of Section 10-3 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida and these Solicitation and Contract Documents, the Bidder must hold a valid, current, and active:
  - a. Certificate of Competency as a General Engineering Contractor or as a Specialty Engineering Contractor, commensurate to the requirements of the Project's Scope of Work, in one or more engineering crafts to include Structural Engineering. The Specialty Contractor shall subcontract with a qualified contractor any work which is incidental to the specialty but is specified in the aforementioned Code as being the work of other than that of the Engineering Specialty for which certified; or
  - b. Pursuant to Section 255.20, Florida Statues (F.S.) and in lieu of the above, the County may consider a bid from a Bidder that is a duly licensed Contractor in good standing that has been pre-qualified and considered eligible by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) under Section 337.14, F.S. and Chapter 14-2, Florida Administrative Code, to perform the work described in the Contract Documents. Contractors seeking consideration under this paragraph shall submit along with the Bid Documents for review and consideration, current copy(ies) of their FDOT Certificate(s) of Qualification, Certification of Work Underway, and Status of Contract(s) On Hand. Acceptable FDOT prequalification(s) necessary to perform the work specified in the Project's Scope of Work shall include the Minor, or Major bridge Work Class.

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#### **EXPERIENCE**:

#### **Experience Requirement:**

- 1. The Bidder must demonstrate that it has full-time personnel with the necessary experience to perform the Project's Scope of Work. This experience shall include work in successfully completed projects performed by the identified personnel whose bulk of work performed in the Public Right-of-Way is similar in detail to the Project's Scope of Work described in these Solicitation Documents. Demonstrate the experience requirement by:
  - a. Providing a detailed description of at least five (5) projects similar in detail to the Project's Scope of Work described in these Solicitation Documents and in which the Bidder's identified personnel is currently engaged or has completed. List and describe the aforementioned projects and state whether the work was performed for the County, other government clients, or private entities. The description must identify for each project:
    - The identified personnel and their assigned role and responsibilities for the listed project
    - 2) The client name and address including a contact person and phone number for reference
    - 3) Description of work
    - 4) Total dollar value of the contract
    - 5) Contract duration
    - 6) Statement or notation of whether Bidder's referenced personnel is/was employed by the prime contractor or subcontractor, and
    - 7) For completed projects, provide letters of certification of final acceptance or similar project closure documentation issued by the client and available Contractor's performance evaluations.
- 2. In addition, the contractor must have previous experience in the installation of the specified carbon wrap product and provide a notarized certification letter from the CFRP manufacturer, attesting the Contractor is currently qualified to install the materials. The Foreman who will perform CFRP installation of the specified product, shall have a minimum of 2 years' experience installing this product. Provide a notarized certification letter stating that the Foreman is qualified to install the manufacturer's CFRP.
- 3. The CFRP manufacturer or supplier shall specialize in the manufacturing of the products specified in Article T104-1.1 (b) of the Technical Special Provision, and have documented experience as noted in.
- 4. The County reserves the right to request additional information and/or contact listed persons pertaining to bidder's experience.

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## CHANGES TO SUPPLEMENTARY INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS:

A. At the Article 1.07, delete subarticles A. Certificate of Competency Requirement, and B. Experience Requirement and replace both in the entirely with the same language used above for the Invitation to Bid.
