QUESTION: 1) Please confirm the center curbed medians need to be swept Eastbound and Westbound each time as well.

RESPONSE: 1) Yes, the center curbed median (Eastbound and Westbound) need to be swept each time.

QUESTION: 2) Is a truck mounted attenuator required to follow the sweeper?

RESPONSE: 2) DTPW will waive the attenuator requirement for this contract, given the constrains of the protected bike lane and considering the posted speed limit on the causeway is only 25 MPH.

QUESTION: 3) On San Marco Island in addition to the green bike path lanes, do the 4 corners marked in yellow on page 231 of the bid document get swept also?

RESPONSE: 3) Yes, per the project scope of work, sweeping services include the islands four corner side quadrants on San Marco Island.

QUESTION: 4) Reference length being 5.2 miles (2.6 x 2) . If the median curbs and 4 corners on San Marco Island are included, do bidders need to add these areas to the 5.2 miles?

RESPONSE: 4) The median curbs and 4 corners on San Marco Island must be included in the contractor’s bid.

QUESTION: 5) Please confirm which Trade/Work level classification does a street sweeper operator fall under in the “Responsible Wages & Benefits Schedule”?

RESPONSE: 5) If you do not find a wage classification in the Wages and Benefits Schedule that describes the work actually being done, you must contact Small Business Development. Questions concerning the comparability of worker classifications, or the applicability of Davis Bacon classifications will be determined by the County.



QUESTION: 6) Please confirm biweekly payroll needs to be submitted through the LCP Tracker.

RESPONSE: 6) Refer to Article 1.02 Applicable Wage Rates of the Supplementary Conditions of the Solicitation Documents.

QUESTION: 1) The bike path width measures approximately 5 ft. What model/type of piece of equipment is currently being used to clean the bike paths?

RESPONSE: 1) Our department doesn't currently have equipment capable of sweeping the narrow bike lanes, hence the need to contract out the work. There are compact street sweepers in the market used for this type of application, but it would be up to the contractor to decide which model/type to use.
