QUESTION: 25) Please confirm that any utility relocation, or utilities coordination that may hinder the ability to begin construction of the project without restrictions, will be completed before issuance of an NTP and within a reasonably brief amount of time since a notice of award is issued.

RESPONSE: 25) The County acknowledges the critical importance of ensuring that all utility relocations and associated coordination activities are addressed in a manner that supports the timely commencement of construction. It is our intent to complete any necessary utility coordination and relocations that could impede an unrestricted start of the project prior to the issuance of the Notice to Proceed (NTP). These efforts will be undertaken promptly following the Notice of Award to minimize any potential delays and maintain the project schedule.

QUESTION: 26) If any utilities will be relocated during construction, please advise as to what date these relocations will be completed by.

RESPONSE: 26) In the event that any utility relocations are required to occur concurrently with construction activities, a detailed schedule will be provided identifying the anticipated completion dates for each relocation. These dates will be established in coordination with the respective utility providers to ensure alignment with the overall project timeline and minimize impacts to construction sequencing.

QUESTION: 1) The areas of contaminated material shown in the Soil Management Plan do not match those shown in the cross sections. Please clarify what information we should use to calculate the volumes of contaminated material.

RESPONSE: 1) Pay Item 125-4-3, Contaminated Solid Waste Removal and Disposal, was added to the bid form under Addendum No. 1 and will be used for the removal and disposal of contaminated soil and solid waste. Pay Item 120-4, Subsoil Excavation, will be used for the removal of unsuitable material, such as muck. The Contractor shall refer to and follow the approved Soil Management Plan (SMP) and Health and Safety Plan (HASP) provided in

Volume III – Permits. A minimum of 2 feet of solid waste/contaminated soils, as identified in both the cross sections and the SMP, shall be removed in the designated areas of concern located outside of the proposed canal excavation.

QUESTION: 1) According to Soil Management Plan there are 57,896 CY of contaminated material on whole project, (42,000 CY outside of the channel). On the bid items there are 80,885 CY of subsoil excavation. Does this include the 57,896 CY of Contaminants called out in the SMP? Or are they two separate numbers.

RESPONSE: 1) Please refer to response for Question #1 on response letter 1 from Santiago Lopez, H&R Paving; dated April 24, 2025.

RFI from Ms. Hamill Andrade, Ric-Man International, Inc; dated 5/19/2025. (attached)

QUESTION: 1) Regarding Temp Lighting of the project. Will then entire project need temp lighting all at once? does the county have a spec or should we go off FDOT standard?

RESPONSE: 1) Refer to note #6 of the lighting plans general notes.

QUESTION: 2) Please clarify what is to be included in note 28:
What does the additional 20% Pole Assemble include:
We assume the following

- Pole
- Arm
- Fixture

But it could also be:

- Just the pole
- And or
- Concrete base
- And or
- MG Squared Pole cable distribution

RESPONSE: 2) Pole, Arm and Fixture.

RFI from Santiago Lopez, H&R Paving; dated 5/20/2025. (attached)

QUESTION: 1) The response received with RFI regarding Item 400-0-11 Gravity Wall does not clarify our concern. Could you please send us the scheme and height the Gravity Wall will have and the location?. Note that project has a separate item for Retaining Wall and Gravity Wall.

RESPONSE: 1) Pay Item 400-0-11 (Concrete Class NS) shall be used for the construction of concrete collars and pipe plugs, in accordance with FDOT

Standard Plans Index 430-001. Please note that the bid form has been revised under Addendum No. 2 to remove the reference to the Gravity Wall from the description of Item 400-0-11.

RFI from Ms. Hamill Andrade, Ric-Man International, Inc; dated 5/20/2025. (attached)

QUESTION: 1) Are there any permits requiring fees? If yes which agencies and what are the fees?

RESPONSE: 1) The Contractor is responsible for obtaining a Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) permit from the County. The County will cover the costs of all other permits required for the construction of the project

QUESTION: 2) Volume 1 PDF 125 States: "...the testing of samples and materials will be made at the expense of the Owner by the project testing laboratory..." Can we assume that tests such as densities, concrete cylinders, LBRs, etc. are included?

RESPONSE: 2) Yes, standard quality control tests such as density testing, concrete cylinder breaks, and LBRs are included and will be performed at the Owner's expense by the project testing laboratory.

QUESTION: 3) Vol.1 PDF 401, 2.02 "DEPARTMENT-FURNISHED EQUIPMENT INSTALLED BY CONTRACTOR." Please clarify if this is applicable to this project.

RESPONSE: 3) Not applicable to this project.

QUESTION: 4) Vol.1 PDF 261, K. Limitations of Operations, 1 General, c, states: "All construction activities, designated by Engineer as requiring inspection by the County, must be scheduled to coincide with the hours of availability of Engineer or Engineer's duly authorized inspector. The hours of availability are from 7:00 AM until 4:30 PM Monday through Friday; unless otherwise approved by the Engineer, these construction activities must be scheduled to coincide with the aforementioned hours of availability." Based on the 657 contract days, it will likely necessitate working 10+ hour days. Please clarify the language to either allow the additional hours or provide the overtime fees to include in the bid.

RESPONSE: 4) The means and methods for performing construction activities, including scheduling, are the sole responsibility of the Contractor. Any required inspections outside of the standard hours must be coordinated with the Engineer in advance.

RFI from Ms. Hamill Andrade, Ric-Man International, Inc; dated 5/22/2025.

QUESTION: 5) We have observed there is illegal dumping at the project site and no way to determine how much more will occur between now and the contract



award as we have no control to prohibit more illegal dumping. We assume all illegal dumping will be treated as a change order and paid under the contingency line item.

RESPONSE: 5) Thank you for bringing this matter to our attention. Please be advised that any site conditions impacting the scope of work will be evaluated in accordance with the contract terms and applicable procurement procedures.

Good afternoon Ms. Fernandez;

On behalf of JVA Engineering Contractor and having thoroughly reviewed the solicitation documents, we would like to present to the County's consideration, the following questions / requests for clarification.

1. CAR Contractor – Please confirm that there will not be a Contamination Assessment/Remediation Contractor (CAR) assigned to this project.
2. Please confirm there is no Allowance for a Contamination Assessment/Remediation Contractor (CAR).
3. Pay Item 110-1-1B Clearing and Grubbing: -What thickness of superficial material will be considered clearing and grubbing?
4. Pay Item 110-1-1B Clearing and Grubbing: - What treatment -for measuring and billing purposes- will be given to the removal of solid waste found directly on the surface of the ROW?
5. Pay Item 110-1-1B Clearing and Grubbing: -What treatment will be given to solid waste found within the thickness of material, which would ordinarily be considered clearing and grubbing, when performed in clean/undisturbed material and not in soil known to be contaminated with solid waste.
6. Pay Item 120-4 Subsoil excavation: -What is the method of measurement for subsoil excavation?(Surveying, truck loads)
7. Pay Item 120-4 Subsoil excavation: -What are the limits of subsoil excavation? From what depth measured from the surface is excavation considered subsoil excavation?
8. Pay Item 120-4 Subsoil excavation: -What is the criteria used to define subsoil excavation?
9. Pay Item 120-4 Subsoil excavation (solid waste): -Is solid waste above ground considered subsoil excavation for measuring/quantifying purposes?
10. Pay Item 120-4 Subsoil excavation (solid waste): -Is Solid waste encountered within the limits of regular excavation considered subsoil excavation?
11. Pay Item 120-4 Subsoil excavation (solid waste): -What is the max depth of subsoil excavation?
12. Please advise as to type of solid waste that will be encountered and what kind of disposal will be required for it.
13. Pay Item 120-4 Subsoil excavation (solid waste): -Is the entire quantity shown in the bid documents to be considered solid waste?
14. What pay item covers contaminated soil removal?
15. If the soil is found to be contaminated with items/chemicals/elements other than what has already been identified in the soil report, please advise if this is to be treated separately (billed under a different pay item.. if so, which one?).

16. Please advise what is considered contaminated soil. What pollutants and in what ranges would deem a soil contaminated if found on a sample?
17. Please advise who determines if the soil is contaminated.
18. If testing is necessary to perform this determination, whose responsibility is it to perform these tests? Is it a compensable item? Under what pay item?
19. Sheet RD-28 of 86 shows soil removal – what pay item is this quantity to be paid under?
20. FPL Duct bank is shown as a separate contract. Please provide the date when this work will be completed.
21. Please advise on the current status of the FPL Duct Bank project.
22. In case it has been completed, please provide the “As-Builts” of the FPL Duct Bank, NIC and constructed by others.
23. In case it is yet to be built, Please provide current Plans of the FPL duct bank to be constructed by others.
24. Please confirm that all utility relocations will be completely done before NTP is issued.
25. Please confirm that any utility relocation, or utilities coordination that may hinder the ability to begin construction of the project without restrictions, will be completed before issuance of an NTP and within a reasonably brief amount of time since a notice of award is issued.
26. If any utilities will be relocated during construction, please advise as to what date these relocations will be completed by.
27. The plans show encroachments into the road. STA 34+00 has what seems to be a laydown area for the Florida Fruit Lands Company. Please confirm that there will be no encroachments in this nor in any other area of the project.
28. We are waiting for answers on these RFI's. These answers will materially impact our bid amount. Could the County consider extending the bid till after all RFI's are answered?
29. When is the project NTP anticipated?
30. What is the deadline to submit to the County's consideration any additional questions or RFI's?
31. Will the County provide QC and laboratory services?
32. Is there a User Access Program (UAP) fee? Of what percentage?
33. Is there an inspector general fee? Of what percentage?
34. Can the contractor propose a different Temporary Traffic Control Plan (TTCP) or do we have to use the one in the plans?
35. Please confirm contractor is to include Superpave Asphalt SP TL-D with PG 76-22 per typical section criteria?
36. Please confirm contractor is to exclude channel excavation on the section where there is an existing canal?
37. Please clarify the note “coordination and design of this area is in progress and will be finalized during post design?
38. Please confirm the construction time is 600 calendar days. The project's complexity seems to merit more time. DTPW has given more time in similar projects, would a longer contract time be possible?
39. Please confirm if there is any protected tree that needs to be relocated?
40. Please confirm if all trees are going to be removed?

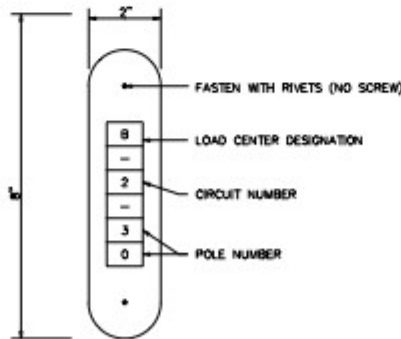

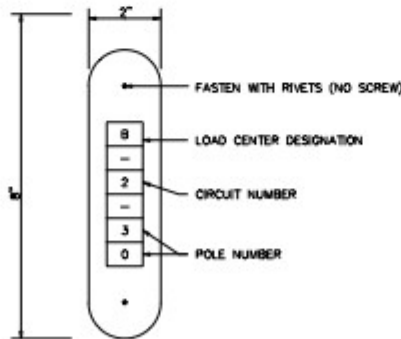

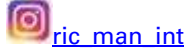
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
