This Addendum forms part of the project solicitation documents and will be incorporated into the Contract Documents, as applicable. Insofar as the Original Contract Documents, Drawings and Specifications are inconsistent, this Addendum shall govern. Please acknowledge receipt of this Addendum, at the time of bid submittal to Miami-Dade County, in the space provided on the "Acknowledgement of Addenda Form" provided with the project solicitation documents. Failure to acknowledge receipt of all addenda may be cause for disqualification.

CHANGES TO THE SCOPE OF WORK:

- A. Clarification to the Scope of Work, related to the limits of the two canopy demolitions.
  - a. Paragraph A: Demolition of both West & South Canopies – Contractor should perform partial demolition of South Canopy as close as possible to the Miami Dade Corrections & Rehabilitation Center Office Building. Partial demolition of West Canopy to the Eastside of MLK Parking Garage Building, as close to the Parking Garage as possible. Structural integrity of the canopies are the responsibility of the contractor.
  - b. Regarding the limits of removal: Removal of all foundations to be included under the Scope of Work.
- B. Clarification to the Provision of Security Guard Services at the Site:
  - a. As a response to one of the questions concerning the cost of security guard, the County will allow members of the construction crew during hours of operation to provide this service. However, the Contractor should provide complete Security Services throughout the duration of the project. Therefore:
    - i. During normal operation hours, while contractor and crew are laboring at the site, the contractor may have a qualified employee on-site in charge of security.
    - ii. A Security Guard Service must be provided on weekends, holidays, and any period when construction activities are not being performed.
- C. Clarification to the Asbestos Report:
  - iii. Asbestos report included under Appendix B of the Special Provisions, does not report any findings of asbestos. However, if contractor encounters any asbestos

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during the demolition, contractor will be responsible for proper handling and disposal of said found asbestos.

CHANGES TO SPECIAL PROVISIONS:

A. Delete Article 2.04 and replace with the following:

2.04 CHAIN LINK FENCE

Contractor to comply with all the requirements of FDOT Section 550, (attached under Appendix A of the Special Provisions) with the following modifications:

A) 550-1, Type of Fence: Select Fencing Type B (Chain Link Fence) adding a top and bottom rail.

B) 550-5, Method of Measurement: Delete in its entirety and replace with:

a. 550-5.1 General: The quantities to be paid for will include a functional 6 feet tall, Type B Fence, with top and bottom rails, two operating gates and two gate locks to coincide with specifics used by Miami-Dade County Madeco's Lock. Fence to include wind screen and silt barriers. Silt barriers to be maintained through the entire length of the contract. Contractor to remove and dispose of silt barriers and wind screen at the end of the construction. Before final acceptance, contractor to replace or repair any damage to the fence and components with functional gates. Contractor to contact Maintenance Facilities to obtain specifications on the Locks to be used.

C) 550-6, Basis of Payment: Delete in its entirety and replace with:

a. Fence and all components, including gates and silt barriers, stated under 550-5 and any incidentals necessary to have a functional gate, to be paid under Pay Item No. 4, Chain Link Fence, Lump sum (L.S.)
