Scope of Work:	<p>(Contractor must obtain and submit all permits prior to performing any work).</p> <p>The Project consists of furnishing all labor, material, and equipment for rehabilitation of approximately (15) fifteen manholes on the 72-inch Biscayne Boulevard Interceptor. The work of the manhole rehabilitation shall include, but not be limited to, excavation; removal of the existing manhole corbel; furnishing and installing HDPE or fiberglass pipe as a manhole repair insert; surface preparation to install the insert repair pipe; pressure washing and repairing grouting voids; preparation of a base to install the insert repair pipe; installing a screen or barrier over the manhole opening to prevent debris from falling into the interceptor; concrete repair and restoration as needed; attaching pipe to the insert repair pipe on the interceptor; filling void in the ground with flowable fill; intercepting connecting gravity sewer systems, handling the flow during the rehab, and reestablishing the connection once the manhole is rehabbed; grouting the annular space between the repair insert pipe and the existing manhole structure; grouting any voids and sealing at the junction of the interceptor and top slab; furnishing and installing new manhole reinforced top slab; furnishing and installing a protective coating for the manhole top slab; furnishing grout and concrete with an anti-microbial additive; furnishing and installing manhole frame and cover; measuring dimensions and making cutting materials to size for the rehabilitation work; complying with all OSHA safety requirements for confined space and personal protective equipment; furnishing and installing flowable fill, if required; traffic control; legal disposal of debris; furnishing and utilizing all required safety equipment; working at low flow times when required; securing City of Miami permits; pavement restoration; and all other miscellaneous and appurtenant work for a complete manhole rehabilitation.</p> <p>The manholes to be repaired are located throughout the North Biscayne Bay 72-inch Interceptor system constructed over 70 years ago. Approximately (15) fifteen of these manholes shall be repaired as part of this project.</p> <p>The Miami Dade County Ordinance No.90-143 is applicable to this Project. The Contractor shall review the "Supplemental General Conditions" and the "Wage and Benefit Schedule" that are included within these documents.</p> <p>It is the intent of the Department to obtain a complete functional, and satisfactory installation under this Contract, and any items of labor, equipment or materials which may reasonably be assumed as necessary to accomplish this end shall be supplied whether or not they are specifically shown on the Plans or stated herein.</p>

All construction services provided under this contract are subject to the 2% UAP. This fee applies to all Contract usage whether by County Departments or by any other governmental, quasi-governmental or not-for-profit entity. From every payment made to the Contractor under this contract (including the payment of retainage), the County will deduct the two percent (2%) UAP fee provided in the ordinance and the Contractor will accept such reduced amount as full compensation for any and all deliverables under the contract. The County shall retain the 2% UAP for use by the County to help defray the cost of its procurement program. Contractor participation in this pay request reduction portion of the UAP is mandatory.</p> <p>Provided, however, UAP shall not be applicable for total contract values, inclusive of contingency and allowance accounts, of less than five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.00).</p> <p>The projects are located: Miami-Dade County, Florida (Various Locations).</p> <p>Licenses Requirements and Additional Qualification of Bidders:</p> <p>A. Further, the successful bidder, before award, shall submit more detailed information on the experience of the firm and personnel assigned to the rehabilitation manhole, and especially the experience of the crew leaders who will supervise the work in the field, as well as information on all equipment and the type of process that will be used for the coating system method.

The Contractor must submit proof that his/her firm has the ability to interface with MD-WASD and familiarity with permits and County guidelines. The ability will be based upon the evaluation of the Company by "Past Performance Evaluations" (PPE) from the Miami-Dade County approach including experience in Manhole Rehabilitation projects under WASD's Contracts.

Submit experience history with a minimum of references on the two most recent Contracts along with the bid. The work should have been completed with the Contractor's own forces or key personnel with any applicable permits secured by the Contractor.

The experience of key senior personnel with other firms may be counted toward the experience requirement, if acceptable to the Engineer. Should such evidence not be satisfactory to the Engineer, whose decision shall be final, the bid will be considered non-responsive, and the second low bidder will be considered for the award.

## **DISCLOSURE:**

- Contractor shall indemnify and hold harmless the County and its officers, employees, agents and instrumentalities from any and all liability, losses or damages, including attorneys' fees and costs of defense, which the County or its officers, employees, agents or instrumentalities may incur as a result of claims, demands, suits, causes of actions or proceedings of any kind or nature arising out of, relating to or resulting from the performance of this Agreement by the Contractor or its employees, agents, servants, partners principals or subcontractors. Contractor shall pay all claims and losses in connection therewith and shall investigate and defend all claims, suits or actions of any kind or nature in the name of the County, where applicable, including appellate proceedings, and shall pay all costs, judgments, and attorney's fees which may issue thereon. Contractor expressly understands and agrees that any insurance protection required by this Agreement or otherwise provided by the Contractor shall in no way limit the responsibility to indemnify, keep and save harmless and defend the County or its officers, employees, agents and instrumentalities as herein provided.

The Contractor shall furnish to **Water and Sewer, 3071 SW 38 Avenue, Douglas Building, Miami FL 33146**, Certificate(s) of Insurance which indicate that insurance coverage has been obtained which meets the requirements as outlined below:

- A.** Worker's Compensation Insurance for all employees of the Contractor as required by Florida Statute 440.
  - a. If applicable should include coverage required under the U.S. Longshoremen and Harbor Workers' Act (USL&H) and/or Jones Act for any activities on or about navigable water.
- B.** Commercial General Liability in an amount not less than \$300,000 per occurrence, and \$600,000 in the aggregate. Miami-Dade County must be shown as an additional insured with respect to this coverage.
- C.** Automobile Liability Insurance covering all owned, non-owned and hired vehicles used in connection with the work, in an amount not less than \$300,000 combined single limit per occurrence for bodily injury and property damage.

\*Under no circumstances are Contractors permitted on the Aviation Department, Aircraft Operating Airside (A.O.A) at Miami International Airport without increasing automobile coverage to \$5 million. Only vehicles owned or leased by a company will be authorized. \$1 million limit applies at all other airports.

- 7360 RPQs are NOT SBE-Con 100% Set-aside solicitation, however the RPQ may be assigned a SBE-Con Trade set-aside and goal. The SBE-Con Trade-aside and goal if applicable will be stipulated on the RPQ and the Invitation to Bid or in the Project's Solicitation Documents.
- All Prime Contractors submitting a bid for RPQ/Project with a Small Business Measures (s) MUST submit the Small Business Development "CERTIFICATE OF ASSURANCE" form properly completed, signed and notarized with their bid document at the time of Bid Submittal. FAILURE TO SUBMIT THE REQUIRED CERTIFICATE OF ASSURANCE FORM AT THE TIME OF BID SUBMISSION SHALL RENDER THE BID NON COMPLIANT TO THE CONTRACT REQUIREMENT AND SECTION 10.33.02 OF THE CODE OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY.
- 7360 RPQs Federally Funded may be subject to the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Program. The DBE goal will be stipulated on the RPQ and the Invitation to Bid or in the Project's Solicitation Documents.
- 7040 and 7360 RPQs with an estimated project value in excess of \$700,000.00 may be assigned a Small Business Enterprise Goods (SBE-G) or Small Business Services (SBE-S) program goal. The SBE-G or SBE-S goal if applicable will be stipulated on the RPQ and the Invitation to Bid or in the Project's Solicitation Documents.
- All RPQs with an estimated project value \$100,000 or above are subject to Responsible Wage Rates. The wage rate will be stipulated on the RPQ and the Invitation to Bid or in the Project's Solicitation Documents.
- All Projects, where price (Proposals/Bids) received are in excess of \$200,000 will require the submission of the Payment and Performance Bond as required by State of Florida Statute.

## **VERIFICATION OF EMPLOYMENT ELIGIBILITY (E-VERIFY):**

By entering the Contract, the Awarded Bidder becomes obligated to comply with the provisions of Section 448.095, Florida Statute, titled "Verification of Employment Eligibility." This includes but is not limited to utilization of the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's E-Verify System to verify the employment eligibility of all newly hired employees by the Awarded Bidder effective, January 1, 2021, and requiring all Subcontractors to provide an affidavit attesting that the Subcontractor does not employ, contract with, or subcontract with, an unauthorized alien. Failure to comply may lead to termination of this Awarded Bidder, or if a Subcontractor knowingly violates the statute, the subcontract must be terminated immediately. Any challenge to termination under this provision must be filed in the Circuit Court no later than twenty (20) calendar days after the date of termination. If this Contract is terminated for a violation of the statute by the Awarded Bidder, the Awarded Bidder may not be awarded a public contract for a period of one year after the date of termination, and the Awarded Bidder may be liable for any additional costs incurred by the County resulting from the termination of the Contract. Public and private employers must enroll in the E-Verify System (<http://www.uscis.gov/e-verify>) and retain the I-9 Forms for inspection.
