Scope of Work:	<p>(Contractor must obtain and submit all permits prior to performing any work).</p> <p>The scope of work of this project consists of the rehabilitation of TEN (10) Biscayne Aquifer wells, as required by the Miami Dade Water and Sewer Department (the DEPARTMENT). The CONTRACTOR shall perform this work at the Southwest wellfield (SWWF) and the Northwest Wellfield (NWWF). SWWF wells #19 and 20 are constructed with a 36-inch (in) diameter casing installed to 35 feet (ft) below land surface and are open holed to approximately 100 feet bls, and wells # 25, 26 and 27 are constructed with a 42-in diameter casing installed to 54 ft bls with an open hole to about 104 ft bls. All 5 wells at the NWWF are constructed with a 48-in diameter casing installed to 46 ft bls with an open hole to about 80 ft bls.</p> <p>The wells at both wellfields are contained in a concrete well house that if modified or damaged during the rehabilitation shall be restored to their normal condition prior to the rehabilitation. The well house dimensions are approximately 15-feet wide by 15-feet long by 12-feet high. All operations on the wells must be facilitated through a removable opening in the well house roof or through access doors on the well house wall.</p> <p>The work to be performed on each well consists of conducting a video survey of the well casing and open hole prior rehabilitation, brush cleaning the well casing, acidizing the well, neutralizing the acid and pumping it out, air developing, conducting a final video survey, removal of debris from the well and from the site. Well disinfection will be performed after all rehabilitation work has been completed and before the pump is placed back in the well. Cleanup, together with all other appurtenant and miscellaneous items of work will also be required.</p> <p>The CONTRACTOR shall provide a water management plan to discharge the well water and solids resulting from the airlifting, including the acid water resulting from the well acidification, and as accepted by the ENGINEER. Comments:	<p>Pursuant to Section 2-8.10 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, this Contract is subject to a user access fee under the County's User Access Program (UAP) in the amount of two percent (2%). All construction services provided under this contract are subject to the 2% UAP. This fee applies to all Contract usage whether by County Departments or by any other governmental, quasi-governmental or not-for-profit entity. From every payment made to the Contractor under this contract (including the payment of retainage), the County will deduct the two percent (2%) UAP fee provided in the ordinance and the Contractor will accept such reduced amount as full compensation for any and all deliverables under the contract. The County shall retain the 2% UAP for use by the County to help defray the cost of its procurement program. Contractor participation in this pay request reduction portion of the UAP is mandatory.</p> <p>Provided, however, UAP shall not be applicable for total contract values, inclusive of contingency and allowance accounts, of less than five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.00).</p> <p>Bid submission must be electronic, through the eBuilder Bid Portal, with a hard copy sent to WASD postmarked within one (1) business day of the bid submittal date, mailed to WASD [3071 SW 38th Avenue, Suite 107, Miami, FL 33146]</p> <p>The original Bid bond Security (in the form of a bid bond or cashier's check) MUST be delivered to WASD, at the address above, BEFORE the bids are opened. However, if multiple bids are submitted by the same company, ALL submitted bids will be rejected.</p> <p>The bid set includes electronic bid instructions. DISCLOSURE:

- Contractor shall indemnify and hold harmless the County and its officers, employees, agents and instrumentalities from any and all liability, losses or damages, including attorneys' fees and costs of defense, which the County or its officers, employees, agents or instrumentalities may incur as a result of claims, demands, suits, causes of actions or proceedings of any kind or nature arising out of, relating to or resulting from the performance of this Agreement by the Contractor or its employees, agents, servants, partners principals or subcontractors. Contractor shall pay all claims and losses in connection therewith and shall investigate and defend all claims, suits or actions of any kind or nature in the name of the County, where applicable, including appellate proceedings, and shall pay all costs, judgments, and attorney's fees which may issue thereon. Contractor expressly understands and agrees that any insurance protection required by this Agreement or otherwise provided by the Contractor shall in no way limit the responsibility to indemnify, keep and save harmless and defend the County or its officers, employees, agents and instrumentalities as herein provided.

The Contractor shall furnish to **Water and Sewer, 3071 SW 38 Avenue, Douglas Building, Miami FL 33146**, Certificate(s) of Insurance which indicate that insurance coverage has been obtained which meets the requirements as outlined below:

- A.** Worker's Compensation Insurance for all employees of the Contractor as required by Florida Statute 440.
 - a. If applicable should include coverage required under the U.S. Longshoremen and Harbor Workers' Act (USL&H) and/or Jones Act for any activities on or about navigable water.
- B.** Commercial General Liability in an amount not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence, and \$2,000,000 in the aggregate. Miami-Dade County must be shown as an additional insured with respect to this coverage.
- C.** Automobile Liability Insurance covering all owned, non-owned and hired vehicles used in connection with the work, in an amount not less than \$1,000,000 combined single limit per occurrence for bodily injury and property damage.

*Under no circumstances are Contractors permitted on the Aviation Department, Aircraft Operating Airside (A.O.A) at Miami International Airport without increasing automobile coverage to \$5 million. Only vehicles owned or leased by a company will be authorized. \$1 million limit applies at all other airports.

VERIFICATION OF EMPLOYMENT ELIGIBILITY (E-VERIFY):

By entering the Contract, the Awarded Bidder becomes obligated to comply with the provisions of Section 448.095, Florida Statute, titled "Verification of Employment Eligibility." This includes but is not limited to utilization of the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's E-Verify System to verify the employment eligibility of all newly hired employees by the Awarded Bidder effective, January 1, 2021, and requiring all Subcontractors to provide an affidavit attesting that the Subcontractor does not employ, contract with, or subcontract with, an unauthorized alien. Failure to comply may lead to termination of this Awarded Bidder, or if a Subcontractor knowingly violates the statute, the subcontract must be terminated immediately. Any challenge to termination under this provision must be filed in the Circuit Court no later than twenty (20) calendar days after the date of termination. If this Contract is terminated for a violation of the statute by the Awarded Bidder, the Awarded Bidder may not be awarded a public contract for a period of one year after the date of termination, and the Awarded Bidder may be liable for any additional costs incurred by the County resulting from the termination of the Contract. Public and private employers must enroll in the E-Verify System (<http://www.uscis.gov/e-verify>) and retain the I-9 Forms for inspection.
