Scope of Work:	<p>(Contractor must obtain and submit all permits prior to performing any work).</p> <p>The Project, including mobilization and demobilization, consists of all materials, labor, and equipment necessary to construct a fully operational PS No. 0374. The scope includes installation of 103 linear feet of 6-inch, 347 linear feet of 8-inch, and 250 linear feet of 12-inch ductile iron pipe and ductile iron fittings for the sewage force main, and 228 linear feet of 8-inch and 198 linear feet of 10-inch C900 PVC pipe for the gravity sewer system. It also includes verification and soft excavation (soft dig) of underground utilities prior to the commencement of work.</p> <p>The project involves the removal of one (1) existing plug and connection to an existing 12-inch sewage force main using a 12-inch solid sleeve. It includes furnishing and constructing automatic air release valve assemblies for the sewage force mains and providing mechanical joint restraints. A core drill connection will be made to an existing gravity sewer manhole to tie in the proposed ductile iron gravity sewer. Additionally, four (4) sanitary sewer manholes will be furnished and constructed to connect the 8-inch C900 PVC gravity sewer along NW 199th Terrace and the 10-inch C900 PVC gravity sewer along NW 27th Court. An existing 6-foot wet well will be converted into a manhole with a concrete protective coating.</p> <p>The project includes furnishing and installing two new submersible FLYGT NP 3153.095 pumps, each with 253 mm impellers, 15 HP, and operating at 1755 rpm, along with all related equipment. All pipes, fittings, and appurtenances for the proposed PS will be furnished and installed, including emergency pump-out piping connections and a water line with a backflow preventer. A new valve vault, including check valves and all necessary connections, will be installed over a 6-inch-thick bedding layer of FDOT No. 57 crushed stone.</p> <p>The project also includes furnishing and installing the electrical and control systems, including all necessary electrical wiring and conduits. A 6' high black aluminum picket fence with a Podocarpus shrub border will be constructed. New plastic bollards will be installed, existing ones will be relocated, and the existing gate will be repositioned and fitted with a new "No Parking" sign.". An asphalt driveway and pavement will be furnished and installed, including pavement markings and signage at NW 199th Terrace, NW 27th Court, and NW 199th Street. Sheeting and shoring designated by the Engineer will be left in place. Additional suitable backfill will be provided, if necessary. All materials, equipment, and supplies necessary for cleaning and testing the mains will be furnished.</p> <p>The project also includes cutting, dewatering, filling with flowable fill, and capping of existing ductile iron sewage force mains, as well as furnishing and constructing a reinforced concrete protective slab.</p> <p>Demolition will involve the removal of existing asphalt pavement, sidewalk, and sod, including the transportation, salvage, and legal disposal of demolition debris. Traffic control measures will be implemented throughout construction.</p>						

Temporary and permanent replacement of any damaged pavement, driveways, sidewalks, concrete medians, curbs and gutters, sod, landscaping, and pavement markings will be carried out. Electrical work includes the installation of a light pole inside the easement of PS No. 0374. Coordination with FPL will be required for the provision of a new electrical service from a new pad-mounted transformer.

Finally, all mechanical work, Pump Station startup, and system testing will be completed. This includes testing with the presence of both the incoming gravity sewer pipe and the effluent force main, as well as full testing of the gravity and force main pipelines. The project also includes all other appurtenant and miscellaneous items necessary to deliver complete, satisfactory, and fully functional installation.

PS No. 0374 is located at 19920 NW 27th Court, Miami Gardens, FL 33056, in Section 33, Township 51 South, Range 41 East, within the City of Miami Gardens, Miami-Dade County, Florida.

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Comments:

Pursuant to Section 2-8.10 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, this Contract is subject to a user access fee under the County's User Access Program (UAP) in the amount of two percent (2%). All construction services provided under this contract are subject to the 2% UAP. This fee applies to all Contract usage whether by County Departments or by any other governmental, quasi-governmental or not-for-profit entity. From every payment made to the Contractor under this contract (including the payment of retainage), the County will deduct the two percent (2%) UAP fee provided in the ordinance and the Contractor will accept such reduced amount as full compensation for any and all deliverables under the contract. The County shall retain the 2% UAP for use by the County to help defray the cost of its procurement program. Contractor participation in this pay request reduction portion of the UAP is mandatory.

Provided, however, UAP shall not be applicable for total contract values, inclusive of contingency and allowance accounts, of less than five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.00).

Bid submission must be electronic, through the eBuilder Bid Portal, with a hard copy sent to WASD postmarked within one (1) business day of the bid submittal date, mailed to WASD [3071 SW 38th Avenue, Suite 107, Miami, FL 33146]

The original Bid bond Security (in the form of a bid bond or cashier's check) MUST be delivered

to WASD, at the address above, BEFORE the bids are opened. Failure to deliver the original will result in the bid submission being rejected as non-responsive.

Invited bidders should have received an Invitation to Bid with an Invitation Key linked to the Invitee's email address. Upon request, an invitation can be sent to multiple email addresses within the same company. However, if multiple bids are submitted by the same company, ALL submitted bids will be rejected.

The bid set includes electronic bid instructions. Training on electronic bid submission is available every Monday from 9 – 10 and every Wednesday from 1 – 2. Email the Contracting Officer or paul.adams@miamidade.gov for further information or to schedule training on alternative dates.

The RFI cut-off date is five (5) business days prior to the bid due date.

Liquidated Damages - \$1,000.00 per day.

The contractor must include in their bid package the following documents:

2. Quotation Forms Pages,
3. Addendums,
4. Bid Bond - Note: A Bid Bond will be required only if the bid meets or exceeds \$200K.

In addition, a Performance and Payment Bond with additional insurance will be required once bid is Awarded and bid meets or exceeds \$200K.

SPD department will process it as a "No Measure" (no SBE Measure), as no applicable service was identified.

DISCLOSURE:

- Contractor shall indemnify and hold harmless the County and its officers, employees, agents and instrumentalities from any and all liability, losses or damages, including attorneys' fees and costs of defense, which the County or its officers, employees, agents or instrumentalities may incur as a result of claims, demands, suits, causes of actions or proceedings of any kind or nature arising out of, relating to or resulting from the performance of this Agreement by the Contractor or its employees, agents, servants, partners principals or subcontractors. Contractor shall pay all claims and losses in connection therewith and shall investigate and defend all claims, suits or actions of any kind or nature in the name of the County, where applicable, including appellate proceedings, and shall pay all costs, judgments, and attorney's fees which may issue thereon. Contractor expressly understands and agrees that any insurance protection required by this Agreement or otherwise provided by the Contractor shall in no way limit the responsibility to indemnify, keep and save harmless and defend the County or its officers, employees, agents and instrumentalities as herein provided.

The Contractor shall furnish to **Water and Sewer, 3071 SW 38 Avenue, Douglas Building, Miami FL 33146**, Certificate(s) of Insurance which indicate that insurance coverage has been obtained which meets the requirements as outlined below:

- A.** Worker's Compensation Insurance for all employees of the Contractor as required by Florida Statute 440.
 - a. If applicable should include coverage required under the U.S. Longshoremen and Harbor Workers' Act (USL&H) and/or Jones Act for any activities on or about navigable water.
- B.** Commercial General Liability in an amount not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence, and \$2,000,000 in the aggregate. Miami-Dade County must be shown as an additional insured with respect to this coverage.
- C.** Automobile Liability Insurance covering all owned, non-owned and hired vehicles used in connection with the work, in an amount not less than \$1,000,000 combined single limit per occurrence for bodily injury and property damage.

*Under no circumstances are Contractors permitted on the Aviation Department, Aircraft Operating Airside (A.O.A) at Miami International Airport without increasing automobile coverage to \$5 million. Only vehicles owned or leased by a company will be authorized. \$1 million limit applies at all other airports.

VERIFICATION OF EMPLOYMENT ELIGIBILITY (E-VERIFY):

By entering the Contract, the Awarded Bidder becomes obligated to comply with the provisions of Section 448.095, Florida Statute, titled "Verification of Employment Eligibility." This includes but is not limited to utilization of the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's E-Verify System to verify the employment eligibility of all newly hired employees by the Awarded Bidder effective, January 1, 2021, and requiring all Subcontractors to provide an affidavit attesting that the Subcontractor does not employ, contract with, or subcontract with, an unauthorized alien. Failure to comply may lead to termination of this Awarded Bidder, or if a Subcontractor knowingly violates the statute, the subcontract must be terminated immediately. Any challenge to termination under this provision must be filed in the Circuit Court no later than twenty (20) calendar days after the date of termination. If this Contract is terminated for a violation of the statute by the Awarded Bidder, the Awarded Bidder may not be awarded a public contract for a period of one year after the date of termination, and the Awarded Bidder may be liable for any additional costs incurred by the County resulting from the termination of the Contract. Public and private employers must enroll in the E-Verify System (<http://www.uscis.gov/e-verify>) and retain the I-9 Forms for inspection.
