Scope of Work:	<p>(Contractor must obtain and submit all permits prior to performing any work).          1.00 SCOPE</p> <p>This project involves providing all labor and equipment for the removal and replacement of existing 8-inch through 12-inch-diameter gravity sewer mains on a full-reach or point-repair basis. It also includes the removal and replacement of sewer laterals, including new lateral installations when necessary and approved by the Construction Manager, as well as all other related and miscellaneous items to ensure a complete, functional, and satisfactory gravity system installation. The project includes furnishing and installing sanitary sewer manholes, reconnecting existing service laterals, and restoring pavement and other infrastructure affected during construction. Work also includes traffic control, temporary and permanent paving, proper disposal of removed materials, and other related tasks to ensure the project is completed successfully.</p> <p>The work shall be performed at various locations throughout Miami-Dade County, under different work orders, as ordered by the Department. This is a non-exclusive contract, and as such, the Department does not guarantee that the full amount of the Contract will be issued to the Contractor. The actual number of Work Orders assigned will be at the Department's discretion and will depend only on its needs.</p> <p>This Contract covers the excavation and replacement of existing sanitary sewer pipes that are in deteriorated condition. As the work involves the replacement of pipes connected to an existing and operational gravity system, trenchless construction methods are deemed unsuitable and shall not be utilized.</p> <p>The Department has allocated certain funds for this project. Should the amounts bid exceed expected levels, the Department reserves the right to either reduce quantities and/or delete elements of the work while proceeding at the prices bid or reject bids and re-advertise as its sole option.</p> <p>This section notifies all prospective bidders that the Contract will be awarded for a maximum not-to-exceed allocation of Five Million Dollars (\$4,000,000.00), inclusive of all dedicated and contingency allowances. The bidding process shall be utilized solely to establish unit prices for the various work items described in the Contract Documents.</p> <p>The total contract award shall be made to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, based on the established unit prices. The maximum cumulative value of work authorized under this Contract shall not exceed the stated allocation of \$4,000,000.00.</p> <p>The bid quantities provided in the Quotation are approximate and intended only to provide a uniform basis for comparison of bids. Actual quantities may be increased, decreased, or omitted at the sole discretion of the Department, contingent upon available funding and project requirements. Payment shall be made only for the actual quantities of work performed, completed, and accepted, based on the unit prices submitted in the Contractor's bid.</p> <p>The Contractor shall complete all authorized work within two hundred eighty-five (285) consecutive calendar days from the date specified in the Notice to Proceed.</p> <p>The Department will furnish the PVC C900, ductile iron pipe, and fittings. The Contractor shall provide all other materials, labor, and equipment as specified or as necessary for a complete Project, including the pickup of all piping and fittings from Department storage areas and their delivery to ditch-side. Where material designated to be furnished by the Department is</p>						

unavailable  
at the Department's Stores, if directed or approved by the Engineer, the Contractor shall obtain all necessary materials and be reimbursed from the Proposal item established for this purpose.

The Department reserves the right to install/replace sanitary sewer gravity mains and appurtenances with its own forces or as a part of another Contract as it deems necessary. The Department also reserves the right to contract separately for the construction of the new sanitary sewer gravity main and appurtenances.

Work also includes bypass pumping of sewage or plugging and monitoring, if needed, and all other appurtenant and miscellaneous related items and work for a completed Project. The terms "work", "construction", "repair", and "cleaning" shall each be construed to denote any and all activities under this contract, regardless of their material or diameter.

Point repairs are defined as repairs 15-feet or less in length between two manholes. Refer to Section 8.00 Bid Items description.

It is the intent of the Department to repair faults in its gravity sewers utilizing modern conventional methods. This includes any items of labor, equipment and materials deemed reasonable and necessary to affect such repairs.

It is the intent of the Department to, where practicable, consolidate groups of work orders that consist of a single repair or a replacement within a sewer element. However, the Department reserves the right to issue independent repair work orders as necessary to expedite the Project or to address emergency conditions. Furthermore, while the Contractor is mobilized, the Department may, at its sole discretion, add additional work orders (whether smaller or larger in scope) to the overall assignment. The number and nature of work orders issued shall be determined exclusively by the Department based on its operational needs at the time.

The Contractor is also alerted that various "Standards" are used herein for reference and criteria, and that he should obtain copies for his general use and protection. Abbreviated titles are used throughout these Specifications, and although most of them are widely known, their complete titles are given below in order to avoid any misunderstanding.

Minimum Requirements of the Bidder

A. License Requirements

1. At the time of Bid and pursuant to the requirements of Section 10-3 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida, and these Solicitation and Contract Documents, the Bidder must hold a valid, current, and active:

a. Certificate of Competency from the County's Construction Trades Qualifying Board as a General Engineering Contractor or as a Pipeline Engineering Contractor. The Pipeline Engineering Contractor shall subcontract with a qualified contractor any work which is incidental to the pipeline specialty but is specified in the aforementioned Code as being the work of other than that of the Engineering Specialty for which the Contractor is certified.

or

b. Certification, as a General Contractor or as an Underground Utility and Excavation Contractor, provided by the State of Florida Construction Industry Licensing Board, pursuant to the provisions of Section 489.115, Florida Statutes.

B. Experience

1. In addition to the license requirements, Bidders are required to submit proof that his/her firm has three (3) separate independent crews available for the duration of

the Contract. Bidders shall provide crew information with their Bid submittal. The three independent crews shall be available at all times unless otherwise approved by the Department.

2. The Contractor shall have available one (1) independent pipeline removal and replacement crew; one (1) Post CCTV Video Inspection Crew, and one (1) Restoration. Each of them will be required to work simultaneously, for at least a portion of the contract period.

3. The Bidder must have a minimum of five (5) years of experience, under its current business name (which can include the expertise of key supervisory employees that would man the project), in the construction of roadway / horizontal projects of similar scope and scale involving public right-of-way construction/installation/repair/replacement of main water distribution systems and/or main sanitary sewer collection systems including gravity sewer service laterals with assemblies, and maintenance of vehicular traffic, supported by references for three (3) projects completed within the past ten (10) years. Submitted reference Projects must demonstrate that the Bidder served as the Prime Contractor for the referenced Projects provided.

4. The Bidder must demonstrate that it has full-time personnel with the necessary experience to perform the Project's Scope of Work. This experience shall include work on completed projects conducted by the identified personnel, whose bulk of work is performed in the public right-of-way and is similar in detail to the Project's Scope of Work described in these Solicitation Documents. Demonstrate the experience requirement by:

a. Providing a detailed description of at least two (2) projects similar in detail to the Project's Scope of Work described in these Solicitation Documents and in which the Bidder's identified personnel are currently engaged or have completed within the past ten (10) years. List and describe the aforementioned projects and state whether the work was performed for the County, other government clients, or private entities. For each project listed, the pipe installation shall have been completed and accepted by the project owner prior to the bid submittal date. The description must identify for each project:

- 1) The identified personnel and their assigned role and responsibilities for the listed project
- 2) The client's name and address, including a contact person and phone number for reference.
- 3) Description of work
- 4) Total dollar value of the contract
- 5) Contract duration
- 6) Statement or notation of whether Bidder's referenced personnel is/was employed by the prime contractor or subcontractor, and
- 7) For completed projects, provide letters of certification of final acceptance or similar project closure documentation issued by the client and available Contractor's performance evaluations.

5. The County reserves the right to request additional information and/or contact listed persons pertaining to the bidder's experience.

## **DISCLOSURE:**

- Contractor shall indemnify and hold harmless the County and its officers, employees, agents and instrumentalities from any and all liability, losses or damages, including attorneys' fees and costs of defense, which the County or its officers, employees, agents or instrumentalities may incur as a result of claims, demands, suits, causes of actions or proceedings of any kind or nature arising out of, relating to or resulting from the performance of this Agreement by the Contractor or its employees, agents, servants, partners principals or subcontractors. Contractor shall pay all claims and losses in connection therewith and shall investigate and defend all claims, suits or actions of any kind or nature in the name of the County, where applicable, including appellate proceedings, and shall pay all costs, judgments, and attorney's fees which may issue thereon. Contractor expressly understands and agrees that any insurance protection required by this Agreement or otherwise provided by the Contractor shall in no way limit the responsibility to indemnify, keep and save harmless and defend the County or its officers, employees, agents and instrumentalities as herein provided.

The Contractor shall furnish to **Water and Sewer, 3071 SW 38 Avenue, Douglas, Miami FI 33146**, Certificate(s) of Insurance which indicate that insurance coverage has been obtained which meets the requirements as outlined below:

- A.** Worker's Compensation Insurance for all employees of the Contractor as required by Florida Statute 440.
  - a. If applicable should include coverage required under the U.S. Longshoremen and Harbor Workers' Act (USL&H) and/or Jones Act for any activities on or about navigable water.
- B.** Commercial General Liability in an amount not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence, and \$2,000,000 in the aggregate. Miami-Dade County must be shown as an additional insured with respect to this coverage.
- C.** Automobile Liability Insurance covering all owned, non-owned and hired vehicles used in connection with the work, in an amount not less than \$1,000,000 combined single limit per occurrence for bodily injury and property damage.

\*Under no circumstances are Contractors permitted on the Aviation Department, Aircraft Operating Airside (A.O.A) at Miami International Airport without increasing automobile coverage to \$5 million. Only vehicles owned or leased by a company will be authorized. \$1 million limit applies at all other airports.

## **VERIFICATION OF EMPLOYMENT ELIGIBILITY (E-VERIFY):**

By entering the Contract, the Awarded Bidder becomes obligated to comply with the provisions of Section 448.095, Florida Statute, titled "Verification of Employment Eligibility." This includes but is not limited to utilization of the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's E-Verify System to verify the employment eligibility of all newly hired employees by the Awarded Bidder effective, January 1, 2021, and requiring all Subcontractors to provide an affidavit attesting that the Subcontractor does not employ, contract with, or subcontract with, an unauthorized alien. Failure to comply may lead to termination of this Awarded Bidder, or if a Subcontractor knowingly violates the statute, the subcontract must be terminated immediately. Any challenge to termination under this provision must be filed in the Circuit Court no later than twenty (20) calendar days after the date of termination. If this Contract is terminated for a violation of the statute by the Awarded Bidder, the Awarded Bidder may not be awarded a public contract for a period of one year after the date of termination, and the Awarded Bidder may be liable for any additional costs incurred by the County resulting from the termination of the Contract. Public and private employers must enroll in the E-Verify System (<http://www.uscis.gov/e-verify>) and retain the I-9 Forms for inspection.
