Prosecution and Completion of work", see Addendum no.1.

Question No.2: According to ITB the project is set to start on Jan 20th, 2026. Is that when the

NTP will be given?

Answer No.2: The date provided in Invitation-To-Bid is solely an estimate, and the actual date

will depend on internal award logistics, including Committee, Citizen's Independent Transportation Trust (CITT), and Board of County Commissioners

(BCC) meeting schedules.

Question No.3: Is the contractor expected to reuse the existing single mode fiber optic cable

between stations, or replace it with new fiber?

Answer No.3: Yes, the contractor is expected to reuse the existing single mode fiber optic

cable between stations. The contractor is not required to install or replace any

fiber optic cable between the stations.

Question No.4: Is the existing fiber network already a ring topology?

Answer No.4: Yes. The existing fiber network that will be provided to the contractor will be a

ring topology.
