2.1 PURPOSE

This Request to Qualify (RTQ) will establish a pool of vendors capable of providing traffic poles, mast heads & street lights poles. Entry into the Pre-Qualification Pool is not a contract between Miami-Dade County and any Vendor, but an acknowledgement that included Vendors meet the qualifications as outline throughout this RTQ. Pre-qualified Vendors will be invited to participate in future competitions. The pool shall be open for Submitters to qualify at any time after the initial RTQ opening date.

2.2 SMALL BUSINESS CONTRACT MEASURES FOR REQUEST TO QUALIFYS (Bid Preference)

A Small Business Enterprise (SBE) bid preference applies to this request to qualify.

For awards valued up to and including \$100,000, a 10% (ten percent) bid preference shall apply for certified Micro Business Enterprise (Micro) Submitters. For awards valued over \$100,000 and up to \$1,000,000, a 10% (ten percent) bid preference shall apply for certified Micro and SBE Submitters. For awards valued over \$1,000,000, a 5% (five percent) bid preference shall apply for certified Micro and SBE bidders.

Micro Business Enterprises and Small Business Enterprises must be certified by Small Business Development under Business Affairs, a division of the Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources (RER) for the type of goods and/or services the enterprise provides in accordance with the applicable commodity code(s) for this request to qualify. A Micro Business Enterprise is a certified SBE firm whose three year average gross revenues does not exceed \$2 million, or is a manufacturer with fifty (50) employees or less, or is a wholesaler with fifteen (15) employees or less. Group 1 Traffic Signal Poles, Mast Arms

1. Submitters shall provide a list of no less than three references who can confirm that the Submitter has successfully provided traffic poles, and mast arms for other entities. The following information shall be provided: name, telephone number and/or e-mail address, and type/model of items sold.
2. Submitters must appear on or must be an Authorized Dealer for a manufacturer appearing on the Florida Department Of Transportation (FDOT) Approved Product List- Section# 649 (Galvanized Steel Strain Poles, Mast Arms and Monotube Assemblies) and the Miami Dade County Traffic Signal and Signs Qualified Product List. 3.1 SCOPE

This solicitation is intended to establish two Groups of Prequalified Vendors. Vendors awarded a contract through this pool shall:
