



**BID No. 5435-0/16; DEWATERING AND TANK CLEANING SERVICES - Prequalification**

**I. Purchasing Instructions:**

**A. Award Description**

This contract was established to pre-qualify bidders for future pricing competition to obtain de-watering and tank cleaning services.

**B. Quotation Directives (RFQ)**

- 1. Prequalified vendors will be invited to participate in spot market purchases as required by the County. When spot market purchases are initiated, pre-qualified vendors shall be invited to offer a fixed price for a specific individual purchase, work order, or specific purchasing period.

The work order will include the location, description and plans, if necessary, covering the scope of work to be completed, and any licenses or certifications required. For purposes of identification and payment, each work order will be uniquely numbered and dated. The solicited vendor(s) shall supply the Project Manager/issuer with a written response within the time frame stipulated in the RFQ.

The County reserves the right to reject any and all proposals based on price or other reasons, to waive irregularities or technicalities, and to re-solicit for all or any part of the work order as deemed in its best interest. The work order may direct the vendor to commence work on a certain day and may specify the amount of time allotted for completion of service.

- 2. ALL quotations issued under this pre-qualification contract must utilize the current and active "Terms and Conditions" (T&C's) that includes the latest legislative changes. Please refer to the Procurement Management link (<http://www.miamidade.gov/procurement/itb-terms-conditions.asp>) to retrieve that latest version of the current T&C's.

**III. Special Notes/Instructions:**

**A. Per Section 2.6; Compliance With Government Standards:**

All services to be purchased under this contract shall be in accordance with all governmental standards, to include, but not limited to, those issued by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA), the National Institute of Occupations Safety Hazards (NIOSH), and the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA). Special attention is made to OSHA's 29CFR 1910 regulations relating to hazardous atmospheres in confined spaces. Contractor will be responsible for ventilation and Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) per OSHA requirements.

The Bidder shall follow all applicable Federal and State Department of Transportation (DOT) regulations. Use or disposal of this material shall either be in accordance with Chapter 62-640 of the Florida Administrative Code F.A.C. and all other applicable laws, permits, and regulations. All disposal, storage, and/or use shall be in compliance with the operating permits for the Wastewater Treatment Plants.

**IV. Pool Contract Award Checklist:**
