Please note the following change(s):

C) This addendum deletes Section 4 and replaces it with the "Revised Section 4" which is attached. The "Revised Section 4" changes the quantities in Item 6, Resource Recovery Facility.

If a bid has been previously submitted prior to this addendum, it must be re-submitted using the "Revised Section 4". Bids will only be accepted on the Revised Section 4. Resubmit the entire bid (Section 4 plus Affidavits).

D) Section 3 is hereby amended to delete the requirement to sandblast, prime and paint the scale from Paragraph 3.3.1 h and move it to Paragraph 3.4.1 as it will be part of the Pre-maintenance inspection as follows:

a) Paragraph 3.3.1 h is deleted.

b) Add the following language to Section 3 Paragraph 3.4.1 as follows:

"All necessary sandblasting, priming and painting of scale equipment shall be performed and billed separately prior to the commencement of the maintenance services. This work may be performed by a subcontractor, subject to, approval by the County."

E) For informational purposes, the following answers are provided with the corresponding questions:

1. Question: Would 2.14 be satisfied by submitting the "State of Florida Bureau of Weights & Measures Registration Certificate"?

Answer: Section 2.14 is for informational purposes. The actual requirements and certificates will be identified and requested in the future requests for quotations under Group A. Therefore, these certificates are not required to be submitted with your bid.

Regarding Pages 12 & 13:

2. Question: There are 2 B-TEK Scales at the South Dade Landfill. There is only 1 listed.

Answer: Refer to Revised Section 4, Bid Submittal Form, Item 3.1, as the quantity listed for the B-TEK Scales is correct as "2".

3. Question: There are 4 B-TEK Scales at the RRF. There are only 2 listed.

Answer: This has been corrected in the Revised Section 4.

Regarding the sandblasting, priming, and painting of the scale equipment:

4. Question: Should this be included in 3.4.1?

Answer: Yes. The sandblasting, priming and painting have been moved to Section 3, Paragraph 3.4.1. Refer to Section D above.

5. Question: How would a bidder bid this accurately if it had never seen the condition of every scale to determine when and how much refinishing would be necessary?


Answer: A pre-bid/site visitation meeting was offered to all bidders to inspect the scales prior to the bid opening. Additionally the refinishing has been moved to Section 3, Paragraph 3.4.1, which is not a part of the bid price.

6. Question: Who determines when the refinishing is "necessary"? The awarded bidder?

Answer: The County and awarded bidder together will determine the needs prior to the commencement of the maintenance services. Therefore, refer to Section 3, Paragraph 3.4.1.
