These standard general terms and conditions are considered nonnegotiable subject to the County's final approval.

SECTION 2
SPECIAL CONDITIONS

SCUBA, SKIN DIVING EQUIPMENT AND REPAIR PARTS

2.1 PURPOSE

The purpose of this solicitation is to establish a contract for the purchase of scuba, skin diving equipment and repair parts for various Miami Dade County departments. Section 4 Bid Submittal Form contains a listing of the items required for this solicitation.

The equipment and parts required are divided into two (2) categories (A & B) and then further broken down by groups of similar items as follows:

1. Category "A" - Scuba & Skin Diving Equipment (includes Groups 1 to 8)
2. Category "B" - Water Rescue Equipment (includes Groups 9 to 10)

2.2 SMALL BUSINESS CONTRACT MEASURES (Bid Preference)

Refer to Section 1, General Terms and Conditions, Subsection 1.43, Small Business Enterprises Measures.

2.3 TERM OF CONTRACT FIVE (5) YEARS (with Price Adjustment)

This contract shall commence on the first calendar day of the month succeeding approval of the contract by the Board of County Commissioners, or designee, unless otherwise stipulated in the Notice of Award Letter which is distributed by the County's Internal Services Department (ISD) Procurement Management Services Division; and contingent upon the completion and submittal of all required bid documents. The contract shall expire on the last day of the sixtieth (60) month of the contract term.

It is the awarded Bidder's responsibility to request any pricing adjustment under this provision. For any adjustment to commence on the anniversary, the awarded Bidder's request for adjustment should be submitted 90 days prior to expiration of the then current contract term for all items. The awarded Bidder's adjustment request should not be in excess of the relevant pricing index change under the Consumer Price Index (CPI), under the City of Miami Group, for all Urban Consumers, under Other Goods and Services.

If no adjustment request is received from the awarded Bidder, the County will assume that the awarded Bidder has agreed that the next term will remain at the current price. Any adjustment request received after the commencement of a new year may not be considered.

The County reserves the right to reject any price adjustments submitted by the awarded Bidder and/or to not continue the contract based on such price adjustments. Continuation of the contract beyond the initial term, and any anniversary term, is a County prerogative, and not a right of the awarded Bidder. This prerogative will be exercised only when such continuation is clearly in the best interest of the County.

2.4 METHOD OF AWARD TO PRIMARY & SECONDARY BIDDERS BY GROUP

Award of this contract will be made to the lowest priced responsive, responsible Bidders on a group by group basis. To be considered for award of a group, the Bidders shall offer prices for all items within a given group.

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The County will determine the low Bidder for each group by totaling the unit prices times the estimated annual quantities for all of the items within each group. If a Bidder fails to submit an offer for all items within the group, its offer for that specific group will be rejected.

While the method of award prescribes the method for determining the lowest responsive, responsible Bidder, the County will award this contract to the designated lowest Bidder as the Primary awarded Bidder and will award this contract to the designated second lowest Bidder as the Secondary awarded Bidder respectively. If the County exercises this right, the Primary Bidder shall have the Primary responsibility to initially perform the service or deliver the goods identified in this contract. If the Primary awarded Bidder fails to perform it may be terminated for default and the County shall have the option to seek the identified goods or services from the Secondary awarded Bidder. During the term of the contract, the County may also make award to the third lowest Bidder as tertiary if the Primary and Secondary awarded Bidders do not perform.

Award to multiple Bidders' is made for the convenience of the County and does not exempt the Primary awarded Bidder from fulfilling its contractual obligations. Failure of any awarded Bidder to perform in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contract may result in the awarded Bidder being deemed in breach of contract. The County may terminate the contract for default and charge the awarded Bidder re-procurement costs, if applicable.

The equipment and parts required are divided into two (2) categories (A & B) and then further broken down by groups of similar items as follows:

1. Category "A" - Scuba & Skin Diving Equipment (includes Groups 1 to 8)
2. Category "B" - Water Rescue Equipment (includes Groups 9 to 10)

MINIMUM QUALIFICATION:

Award of this contract will only be made to responsive, responsible Bidders who meet the minimum qualification are as follows for this Solicitation:

The awarded Bidder shall have ownership/operations experience in Scuba, Skin Diving Equipment and Repair Parts for at least one (1) year. Bidder shall provide three (3) Commercial Business and/or Government Agencies' references for which Scuba, Skin Diving Equipment and Repair Parts services were provided to verify minimum 1 year experience.

The following information shall be provided Company name, mailing address, contact person and title, telephone number, fax number, e-mail address and a brief description of services provided within a year.

2.5 "EQUAL" PRODUCT CAN BE CONSIDERED UPON RECEIPT OF SPECIFIED DATA

The manufacturer's name, brand name and/or model number information contained in this Solicitation are being used for the sole purpose of establishing the minimum requirement of level of quality, standard of performance, and design and is in no way intended to prohibit

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the offer of another manufacturer's items of equal material unless otherwise indicated on the Bid Submittal Form.

This Solicitation requires submission of the following documentation to enable County evaluation of "equal" products:

1. Product Information Sheets
2. Product Samples Upon Specific Request
3. Performance Test Results

If an "equal" product may be considered by the County in accordance with the Bid Submittal Form, the unit shall be equal in quality and standards of performance to the item specified in the Solicitation. Where an "or equal" item is offered, and product information sheets are required, the initial offer must be accompanied with two (2) complete sets of product information sheets (such as factory specifications, standard manufacturer information sheets, catalogues, and brochures), and if required, two (2) copies of performance test results of the unit offered as an equal. Also for product information submittals, all supporting documentation submitted must in total meet the required specifications set forth in this Solicitation.

For "equal" products to be evaluated based on submission of product labels, the initial offer should be accompanied with labels indicating the specification and ingredients for each "or equal" item offered. Failure to meet this requirement may result in your offer being rejected.

The County shall be sole judge of equality, based on the best interests of the County, and its decision in this regard shall be final. Items labeled "No Substitute" on the County's Submittal Form are the only products that will be accepted under this Solicitation.

2.6 METHOD OF PAYMENT

2.7 SHIPPING TERMS: F.O.B. DESTINATION

2.8 A. DELIVERY SHALL BE (5) DAYS AFTER DATE OF ORDER

The awarded Bidder shall make deliveries within five (5) business days after the date of the order. All deliveries shall be made in accordance with good commercial practice and all required delivery timeframes shall be adhered to by the awarded Bidder(s); except in such cases where the delivery will be delayed due to acts of nature, strikes, or other causes beyond the control of the awarded Bidder. In these cases, the awarded Bidder shall notify the County of the delays in advance of the original delivery date so that a revised delivery schedule can be appropriately considered by the County. All products submitted must be in the original manufacturers packaging.

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Certain County employees may be authorized in writing to pick-up materials under this contract. Awarded Bidders shall require presentation of this written authorization. The awarded Bidder shall maintain a copy of the authorization. If the awarded Bidder is in doubt about any aspect of material pick-up, Bidder shall contact the appropriate user department to confirm the authorization.

B. PACKING SLIP/DELIVERY TICKET TO ACCOMPANY ITEMS DURING DELIVERY

The awarded Bidder shall enclose a complete packing slip or delivery ticket with any items to be delivered in conjunction with this Solicitation. The packing slip shall be attached to the shipping carton(s) which contain the items and shall be made available to the County's authorized representative during delivery. The packing slip or delivery ticket shall include, at a minimum, the following information: purchase order number; date of order; a complete listing of items being delivered; and backorder quantities and estimated delivery of backorders if applicable.

2.13 COMPLIANCE WITH FEDERAL STANDARDS

All items to be purchased under this contract shall be in accordance with all governmental standards, to include, but not be limited to, those issued by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA), the National Institute of Occupational Safety Hazards (NIOSH), and the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA).

2.14 AVAILABILITY OF CONTRACT TO OTHER COUNTY DEPARTMENTS:

Although this Solicitation is specific to a County Department, it is hereby agreed and understood that any County department or agency may avail itself of this contract and purchase any and all items specified herein from the awarded Bidder(s) at the contract price(s) established herein. Under these circumstances, a separate purchase order shall be

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issued by the County, which identifies the requirements of the additional County department(s) or agency (ies).

2.15 ITEMS MAY BE ADDED OR DELETED:

It is hereby agreed and understood that similar or additional items may be added to the contract at the County's option. It is also agreed and understood that the County may add or delete items on this contract at the County's option. Awarded Bidder(s) under this contract shall be invited to submit price quotes for these additional items. If these quotes are determined to be fair and reasonable, then the additional items will be awarded to the current contract bidder(s) that offers the lowest acceptable pricing.

2.16 ENVIRONMENTALLY ACCEPTABLE PACKAGING

Effective June 16, 1992, all contracts in excess of ten thousand (\$10,000) dollars will be affected by Resolution Number R738-92 amending Miami-Dade County Administrative Order 3-2 (relating to the procurement of goods and services). As a waste management alternative, and as an additional means of reducing the volume and toxicity of waste and by-products entering Florida's solid waste stream, Miami-Dade County has instituted the following policy with regard to source reduction.

In order to discourage excessive packaging of a product solely for marketing purposes and to encourage packaging for purposes of ensuring durability, re-usability and recyclability. No goods shall be purchased if the goods constitute less than 90 percent (by volume) of the item being purchased or if the goods contain more than 10 percent package and packing material (by volume). No packaging shall be purchased which is not environmentally acceptable packaging.

For purposes of meeting the requirements of this resolution, "Environmentally Acceptable" shall be defined as; any item that is returnable for reuse or recycling, or which is recyclable. In order to insure compliance with this resolution, awarded Bidder(s) shall indicate in the space provided on the Bid/Proposal Submission Form or elsewhere as required by this solicitation, the method to be used for returning packaging materials to the distributor in conjunction with this solicitation and/or by completing the General Services Certification of Recycled Product Content Form indicating the ability of the materials to be recycled through existing recycling collection programs.

Appeals for waiver of these requirements may be made in writing to the County Mayor through the Internal Services Assistant Director, Procurement Management Services. No waiver shall be effective unless approved by a majority vote of the Board of County Commissioners. Offers failing to provide this information may result in being declared non-responsive; however the awarded Bidder(s) shall be given the opportunity to provide the information during the offer evaluation period. At such time, the bidder shall be given fifteen (15) calendar days to submit this information.
