This Addendum is and does become a part of the above-mentioned Invitation to Bid.

- A. Section 2, Paragraph 2.33 is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

2.33 ADVERTISEMENT OF BRANDING

Coke and/or Pepsi branded vending machines are allowed at the stations.

- B. Section 2, Paragraph 2.36 is hereby added to the solicitation.

2.36 Unscheduled Interruption of Vending Services

Upon unscheduled interruption to vending service due to acts of nature, police activity, or other like causes, the Monthly Access Fee (MAF) shall cease when such interruptions affect vending services for more than four (4) hours in a calendar day. Thereafter, the awarded bidder shall be charged the MAF the next uninterrupted day based on a daily prorated basis. Proration shall be based on each calendar day of the month.

- C. Section 3, Paragraph 3.1 is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following to remove reference to "plastic bottles only" and replace with "aluminum cans and plastic bottles only":

3.1 SCOPE

The awarded bidder shall furnish, install, maintain, service, repair and/or replace, and keep fully stocked, automated vending machines for dispensing to the public non-alcoholic beverages (aluminum cans and plastic bottles only), wrapped snack products, candy (excluding gum and like products), and other standard vending items the County will approve and designate from time to time throughout the contract term at the Miami-Dade Transit (MDT) Metrorail and Metromover stations, and other MDT facilities (locations).

Specifically excluded from the scope of this contract are prepared foods such as sandwiches, all tobacco products including smokeless products, all alcohol, and all chewing gum and like products. The County's Project Manager will administer this Contract for the County.

The County retains the right to have the awarded bidder add or remove any or all food product or vending machine at any time. In addition, the awarded bidder may propose to the County additional locations for placing beverage and snack vending machines, and the County retains the right to accept or reject said proposals.

- D. Section 3, Paragraph 3.2 is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following to remove "Quantity of 2 vending machines" and replace with "Quantity of 4 vending machines" for the Palmetto Metrorail Station:

3.2 STATIONS/ LOCATIONS AND NUMBER OF MACHINES

Vending machines shall be placed/ installed by the awarded bidder at the locations listed below. The electrical outlet(s) to be used in Phase 1 station locations will be identified by the MDT representative during the site visit of Phase 1 stations. Due to the need for required electrical upgrades for stations included in Phase 2, as listed below in Subsection 3.2.2, these stations will be made available to the awarded bidder at a later date. These additional stations and other facilities may be added during the term of the contract as part of Phase 2 at the sole option of the County following completion of the required electrical upgrades.

E. The following are questions received and corresponding responses:

1. Has the incumbent paid any infraction fees as per Section 2, Paragraph 2.32?

Response: No

2. Are shell enclosures or cages acceptable?

Response: No

3. Define Gross Sales.

Response: Total amount of sales before deducting taxes.

4. Is eating snacks/drinking beverages permitted at train stations?

Response: On December 2, 2008, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Ordinance 08-136, which modified Ordinance Section 30B-4(6) of the Code of Miami-Dade County to allow for the consumption of food and beverages at Metrorail and Metromover station interiors and on the platforms; however, not inside the Metrorail trains.

5. Are two beverage machines permitted?

Response: Electrical capacity at stations will only accommodate one snack and one beverage vending machine per station.

6. Can the snacks be in a chilled vending machine?

Response: No, because of answer above on electrical capacity.

7. Can additional vending machines be added?

Response: Two additional machines (snack and beverage) will be added to the Palmetto Station location (refer to Subsection 3.2.1).

8. Can a copy of the sign-in sheet be obtained?

Response: See attached sign-in sheet for the Pre-Bid meeting and Site Visit dated May 7th, 2012.

All terms, covenants and conditions of the subject solicitation and any addenda issued thereto shall apply, except to the extent herein amended.
