Dear Israel Reyes:

In accordance with Sections 2-8.3 and 2-8.4 of the Code of Miami-Dade County and Implementing Order 3-21, this letter serves to notify you and all bidders on this solicitation that your firm has been recommended for award of the referenced Request for Price Quotation (RPQ) based on the bid submitted on Friday, December 13, 2013. Pursuant to the referenced legislation, the three (3) day protest period shall commence upon the posting of this recommendation to award. This contract award will be effective only in accordance with the conditions of the solicitation, which requires execution by both parties of the Notice to Proceed (NTP).

The value at award is \$180,000.00. The contract term is 540 calendar days. The award is contingent upon the submission and approval by the County of the items listed below:

Please be advised that the total award amount for this RPQ shall not exceed \$180,000.00. Work orders up to a maximum amount of \$50,000.00 shall be issued to your firm on a rotational as-needed basis as indicated in the RPQ.

- Current insurance certificates including the additional \$5 million requirement for Airside access.
- Signed Collusion Affidavit.
- Copy of active trade license.
- Copy of your firm's Safety Plan.
- Supplier/Subcontractor Listing Form #SUB 100 Rev.6/12 (suppliers only).
- ISO 14001 awareness training and certificate for all employees.
- Executed copies of the ISO 14001 Affidavit for your firm and any suppliers expected to deliver equipment and/or materials to the facility.
- Request forms for MDAD identification badges for all staff that will perform work on this pilot program.

Regarding the employees that you will be submitting for security badges, please submit the badging request forms immediately in order to expedite their processing. In the interim, in order to expedite the performance of required work, upon issuance of NTP and subsequent work orders, MDAD may escort up to five (5) non-badged employees to pre-determined work areas so that work can proceed.

The preceding Documents are required as outlined within the MCC 7040 Plan. They must be submitted to the Aviation within 10 business days of receipt of this letter. In the event additional insurance is required, it also must be submitted within 10 business days. Failure to submit the documents within the specified time frame, or an extension approved by the County, will result in the award being rescinded.

Subsequent to the review and approval of the referenced documents, you are required to obtain the necessary permits in the time frame stipulated in the RPQ. Upon obtaining the permit(s), copies must be submitted to the Project Manager prior to commencement of work. No work is to be performed without a permit (if applicable). Following receipt of the permit(s), the Project Manager may schedule a pre-construction conference and issue a Notice to Proceed authorizing the performance of the work.

This letter shall also serve as a reminder that all work must be performed in accordance with the scope of work and contract terms and conditions, all permits and inspections and in accordance with all applicable Federal, State and local laws, codes and regulations.
