The County Mayor, Miami-Dade County, pursuant to Chapter 287.055, Florida Statutes, Sections 2-8.1 and 2-10.4 of the Miami-Dade County Code, Implementing Order 3-34, and Administrative Order 3-39, announces that the Miami-Dade Public Works and Waste Management Department (PWWM) will require one (1) qualified consultant to provide design services for the roadway improvements to West Dixie Highway from NE 164<sup>th</sup> Street to NE 173<sup>rd</sup> Street.

The Consultant shall provide engineering design services and preparation of complete construction plans, to include master planning and public involvement, for the widening of the existing roadway from two (2) lanes to a four (4) lane divided roadway. The proposed improvements include, but are not limited to: raised landscape medians, bicycle lanes, sidewalks, curb & gutter, signalization improvements, pavement markings and signing, roadway lighting, continuous storm drainage system, replacement and widening of the existing bridge crossing over the Snake Creek Canal, and right-of-way acquisition. Additionally, services include environmental permitting, construction administration services and all necessary incidental items for a complete project. Funding for this project will be provided by the District 3, Road Impact Fee fund. The project length is approximately 0.70 miles.

The prime Consultant needs to have at least five (5) years of experience as a prime consultant in the design of major roadway projects.

The Agreement shall remain in full force and effect for three (3) years after its date of execution or until completion of all project phases, whichever occurs last, unless terminated by mutual consent of the parties hereto. Maximum compensation is four hundred and eighty thousand dollars (\$480,000.00), inclusive of a 10 % contingency.
